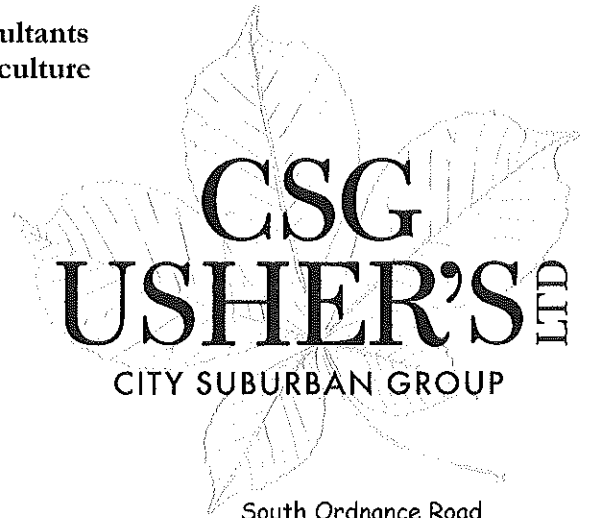

JOB DESCRIPTION

REAR GARDEN with side access:

Trees numbered as per enclosed plan.

T1 = Lime - Close to house. Remove all growth formed since last reduction.

T2 = ACACIA - Clean through crown removing deadwood.

T3 = PEAR - Lightly reduce and prune to shape.

G4 = MIXED HEDGE - Reduce to 2.5 metres and trim one side.

T6 = LOMBARDY POPLAR - Decayed and dangerous. Fell as close as possible to ground level.

T7 = MATURE SYCAMORE - Remove deadwood only.

G8 = VARIOUS ACACIA (In adjacent garden) - lift & cut back over gdn of No.55

T9 = MATURE ASH - Decay noted in lower crown. Cut back crown to points of previous reduction, reduce large decayed limb over garden by 50%

To supply and plant 2 x LOMBARDY POPLAR (Bare Root) 6 - 8 ft
