Garrya Elliptica - (Shrub) - Judiciously reduce crown by 20-25%, raise crown over prospective area for new steps and reduce back from boundary wall.
Griselinia - (Shrub) - Reduce crown by 20%, raise crown over window and drive by removal of one low stem to allow suitable access beneath tree for re-landscaping works.
All works are due to general maintenance and new re-landscaping project.
