Every effort is made to reduce the impact of domination of the front and designed to be sympathetic to the street face.

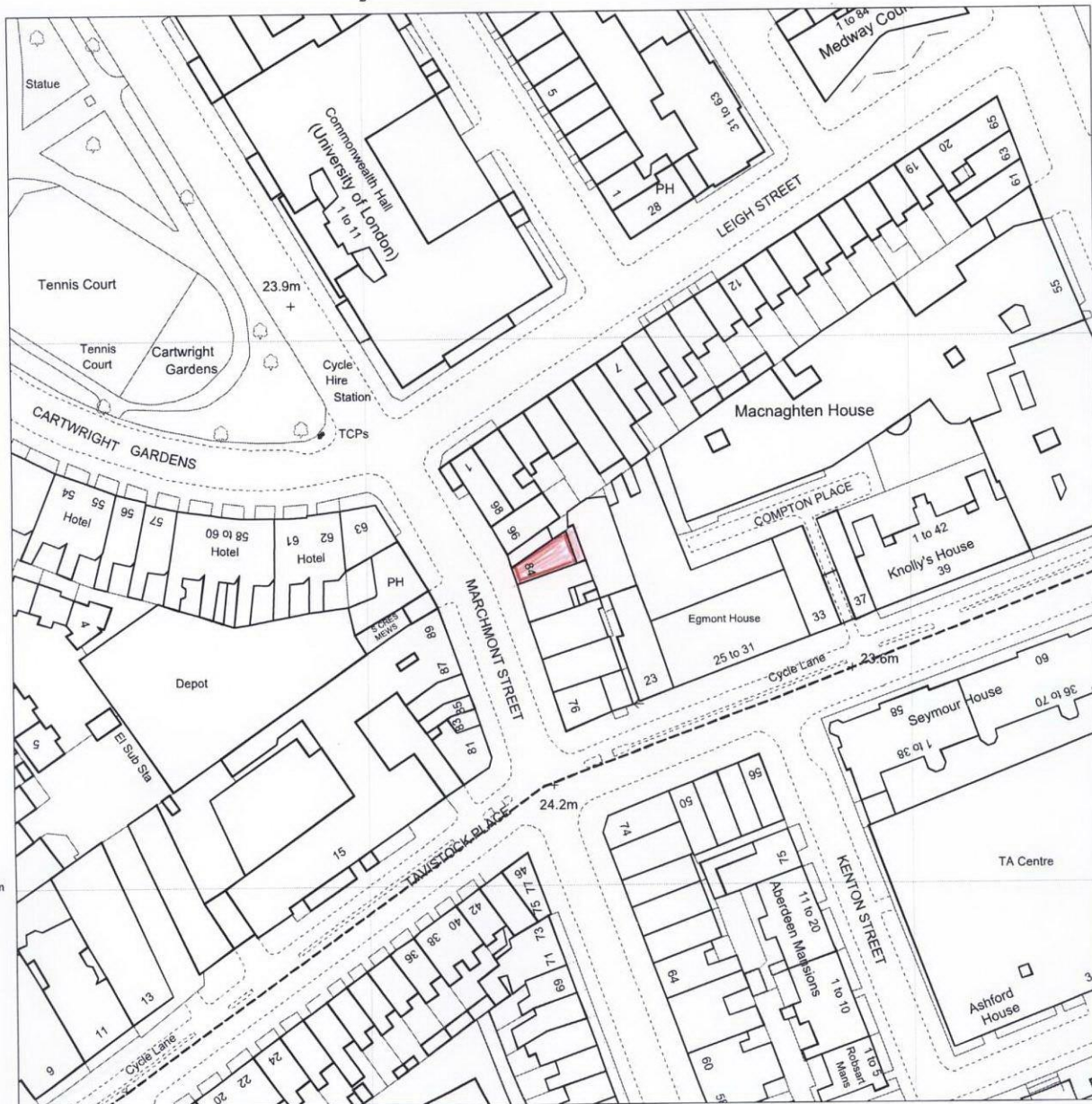
Sustainability and sustainable construction

To minimize the impact on environment there are no lion lights or spot lights. The construction will be carried out to the requirement of the Building Regulations, ie in terms of safety, fire regulations and so on.. Energy saving bulbs will be source of light in the shop.

Because of the existing level inside of the shop and outside the footpath access for disable person will not be affected. The existing width of the door is more than 1M wide, more than require for wheelchair..
