Side of house overhanging Shepherds Walk:

Sycamore Overhanging Shepherds Walk. Reduce crown by 25-30%, remove ivy, dead wood and broken branches. 3 x Acacia: Reduce back form Shepherds walk, judiciously reduce crowns by 20% ensuring screen in maintained. Reasons - General maintenance and hazard management over public walk way.
