- 1 The street scene will be improved by the removal of brightly coloured projecting signage and replacement with 3no.thin panel suspended signs from a black iron cantilever bracket. Two signs positioned next to the left and right hand pilasters and one just above the right hand bracket to the pilaster. The style of these signs is intended to harmonise with the period style of the shop front. These are shown on detail drawing 11-06-05
- 2 Prominent CCTV cameras to be replaced with small discreet cameras in a similar position. These are shown on detail drawing 11-06-04
- 3 Removal of single security alarm box and its replacement with a single small alarm box painted black.

- 4 Removal of the group of 3 no security alarm boxes.

These to be 'one over one' panes as approved on the planning application /consent PE9900348 and as acknowledged by the Planning Inspector paragraph 37 of appeal decision.
