Following our various e-mail correspondence in relation to the invalid application 2011/3803/INVALID, I now have the pleasure of enclosing the revised information that you requested.

The attached Invalid Checklist sets out the information that you requested and our response to it. However, I feel that there are a couple of points worth noting.

Firstly, the description of the development has changed. This is because applications 2010/6690/P and listed building consent 2010/6693/L have already been implemented and these units have been installed. Therefore, this proposal is for just 4 x units on the roof, rather than the 8 previously advised.

Secondly, you asked for all the existing and proposed information submitted under 2010/6690/P. This actually only comprised of an existing and proposed plan with the details that were on them. The proposed plan under the previous application is therefore the existing plan under this application. It is provided here as part of the application.

Finally, due to files size, the appendices for the statement, which include the manufacturers details and method of fixing to the roof have had to be submitted as separate documents. However, they all form part of the Combined Planning, Heritage and Design and Access Statement.
