have a Ceanothus (Californian Lilac) tree growing in my back garden, at the top right hand side. The tree is about 20-25ft in height with a spread of about 20ft. The trunk of the tree has split, making it potentially dangerous. Also, the tree is causing excessive shading for a small urban garden. have contacted a tree surgeon (Matthew Cocks), who has suggested cutting the tree back to below the split in the trunk, leaving 3ft of tree. As there is foliage on the main runk/stem below 3ft, it is very likely that new foliage will grow from the stem at 3ft. allowing the tree to survive.
