Design and Access Statement

(In support of previous application 2011/4231/INVALID)

Our intention was to design and create a bright, clean, well maintained clinic which involved a sympathetic and temporary redecoration of the existing space.

The design of the stud walls has been such that the historic fabric of the premises is not compromised in any way, and the walls remain temporary, thus being removable without trace come the end of the lease in 2014. The walls follow the natural division of the room and the windows, allowing for a positive use of the space inside.

The submitted drawings show that no historic features have been harmed through the works. The access to the building remains unchanged.
