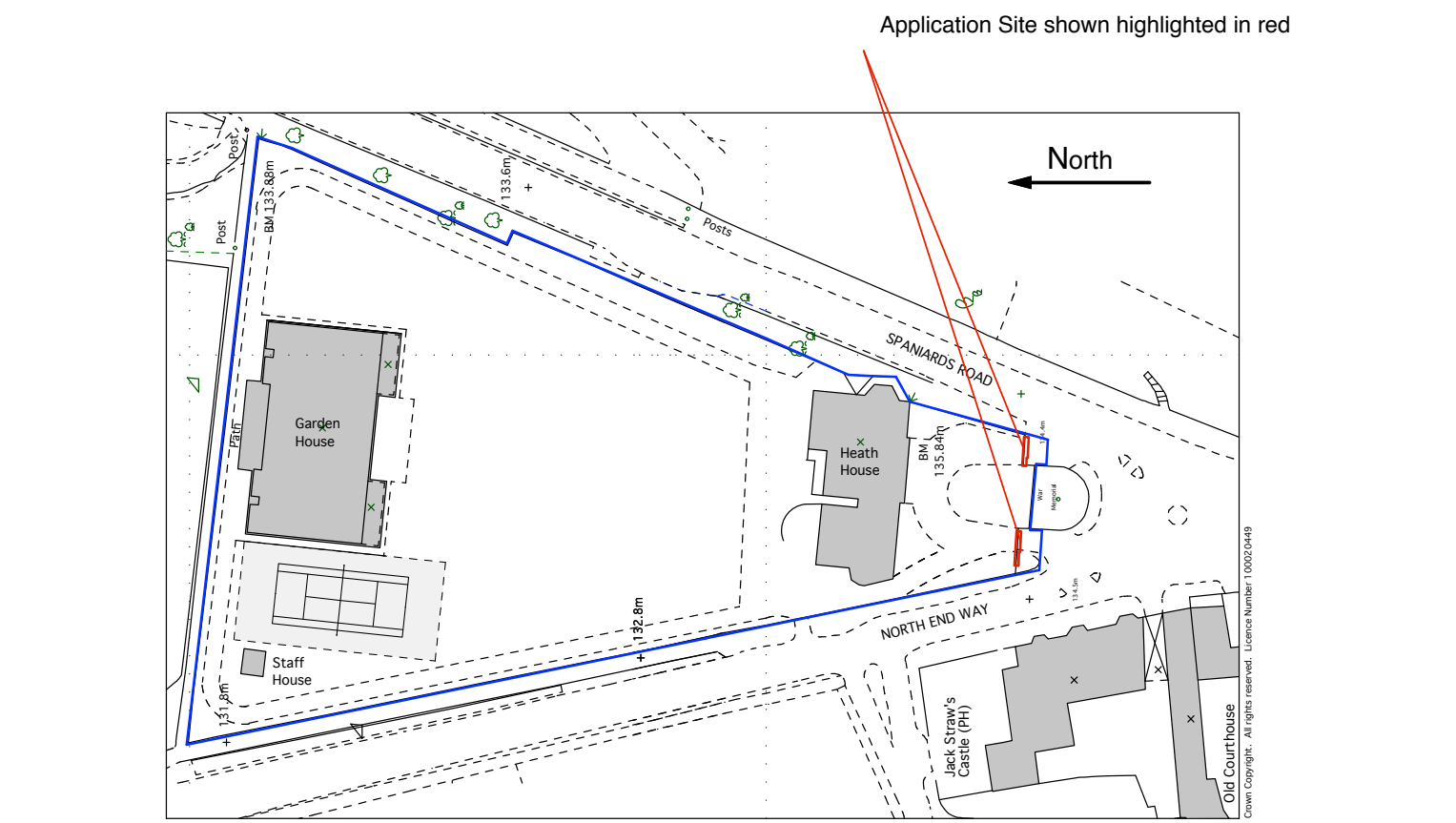


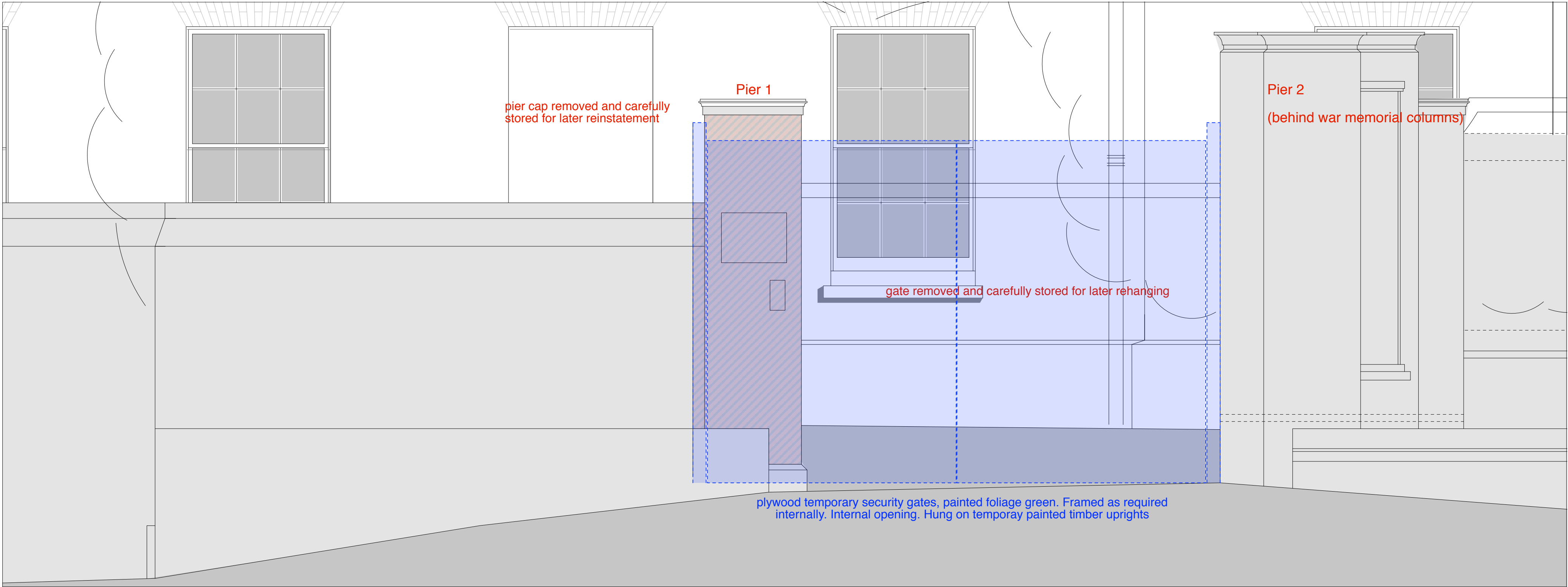
1:250 Block Location Plan: Application site shown in red



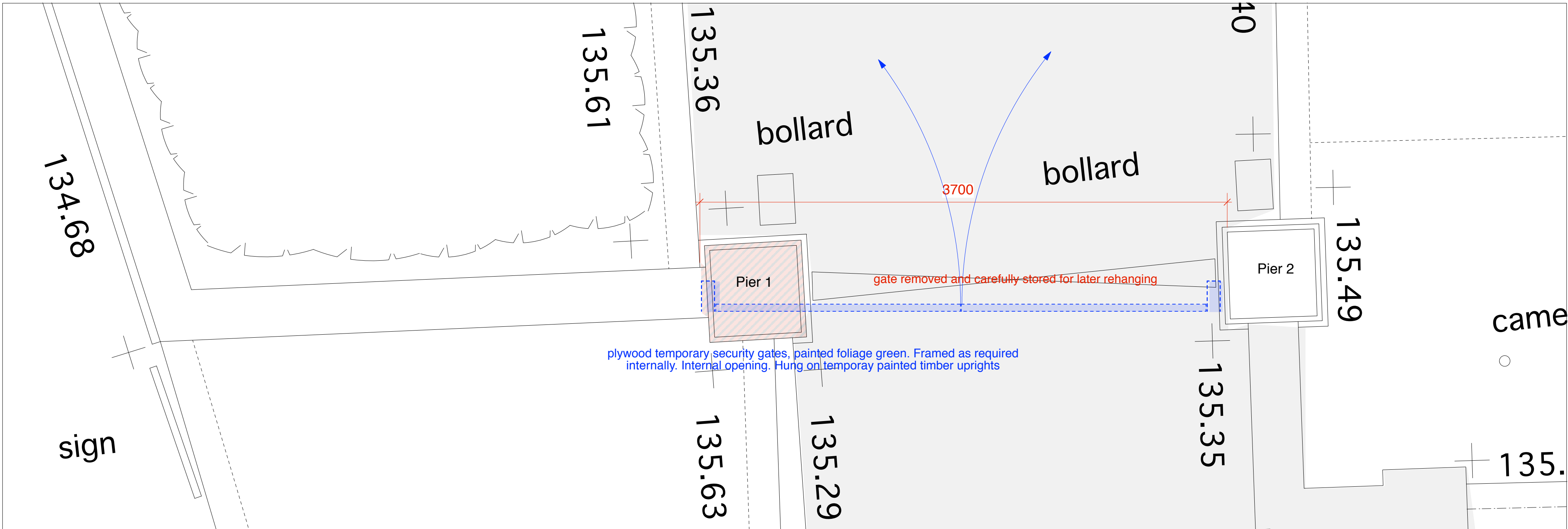
1:1250 OS Location Plan: Application site shown in red, further land owned by the applicant shown outlined in blue

Detail of existing Pier 1 to be demolished and rebuilt to match Pier 2, existing gates removed and carefully stored for later rehanging

Pier 1 to be taken down, pier cap to be carefully set aside for later reuse.

Temporay painted 2.4m high plywood access gates erected on suitable posts to give 3.7m clear opening

At the end of the relevant part of works requiring widened access wall and pier are to be reinstated.

Wall is to be reconstructed from 50/50 Ibstock West Hoathly Handmade 65mm brick and Ibstock West Hoathly Multi bricks in Hawkstone Lime mortar with rubbed and brushed joint coursing and bond to match existing

Pier is to be reconstructed from 50/50 Ibstock West Hoathly Handmade 65mm brick and Ibstock West Hoathly Multi bricks in Hawkstone Lime mortar with rubbed and brushed joint, coursing to match Pier 2. Existing pier cap reinstated on new pier.
