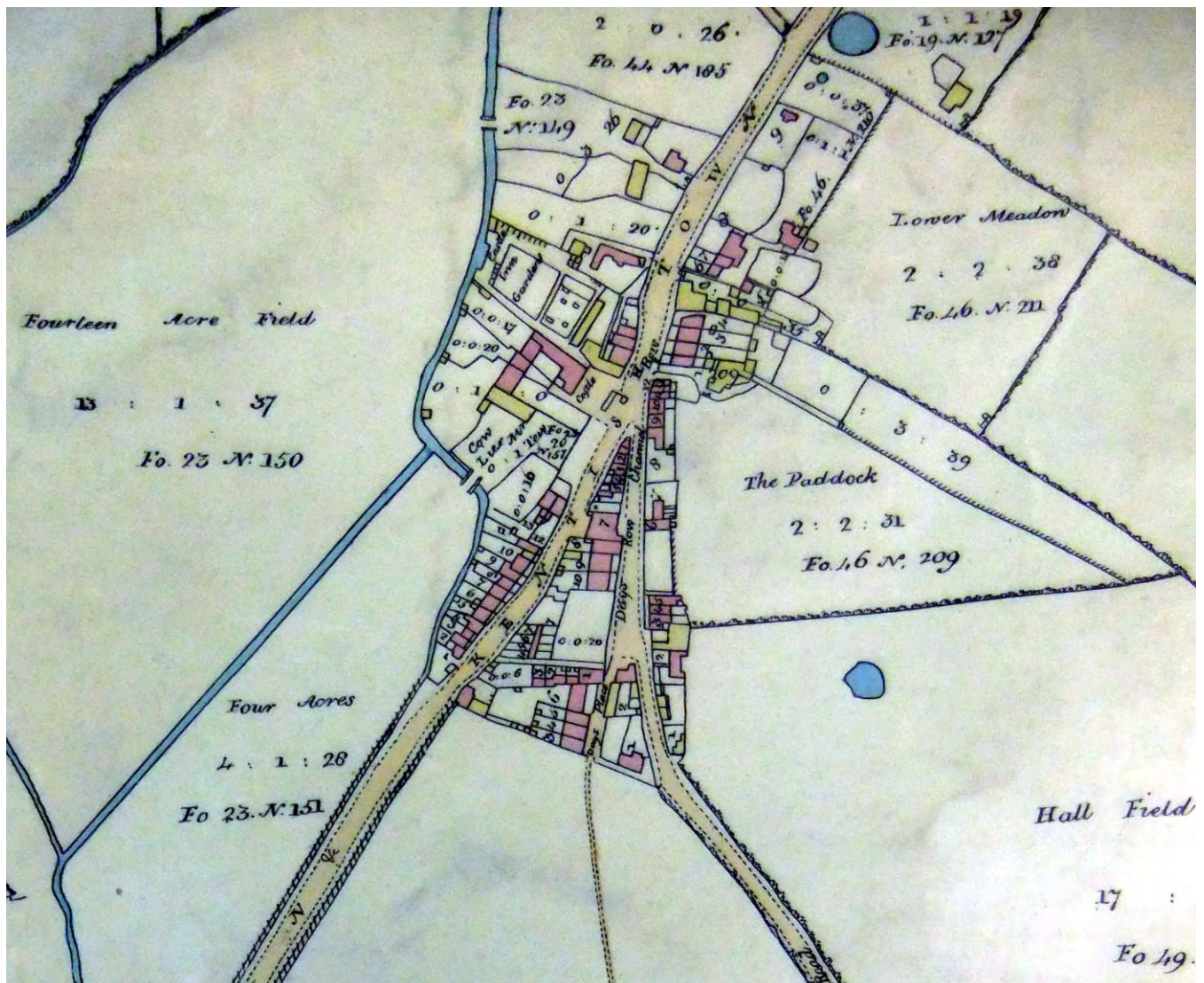

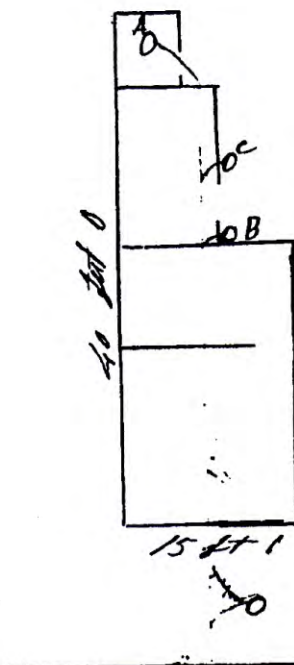

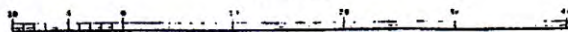

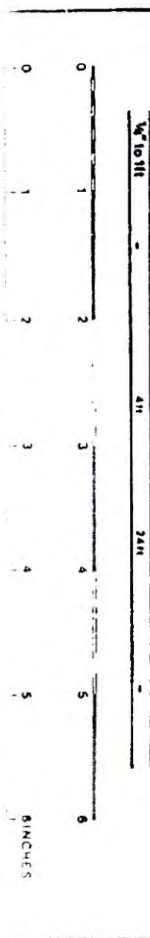

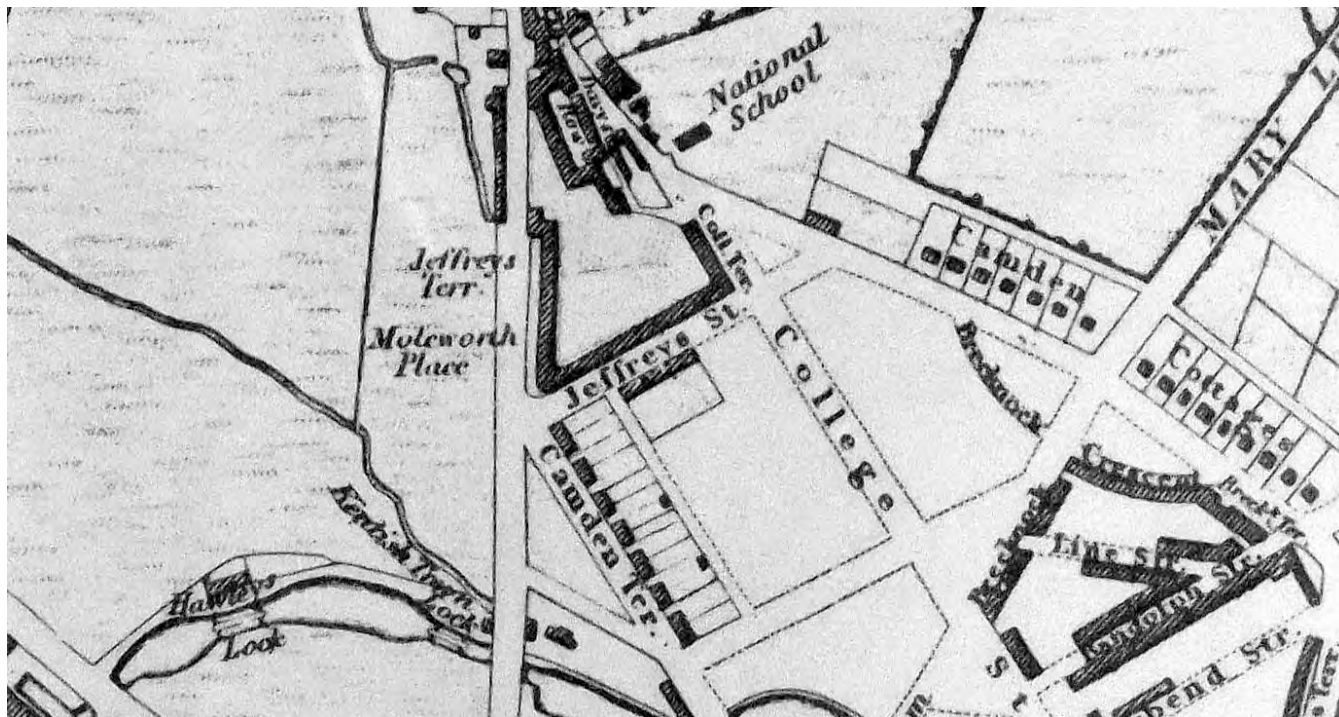

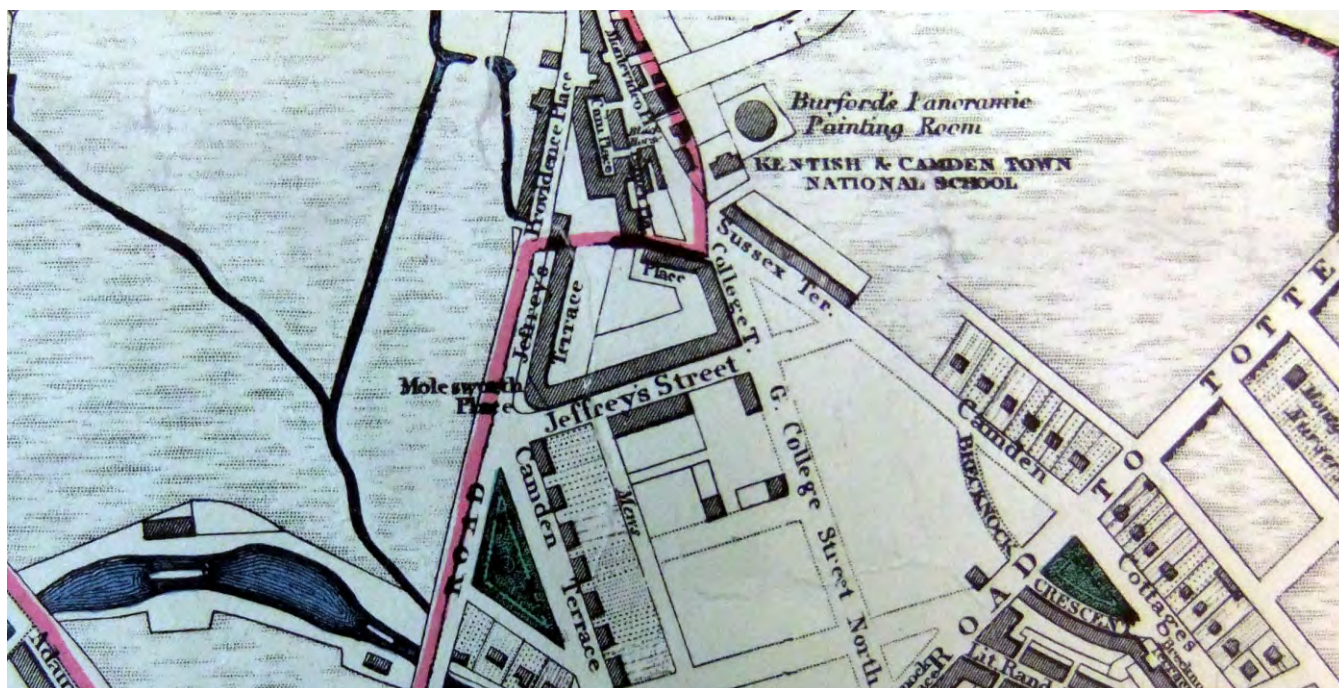

Appendix 3: 3.2 Block plan of the building, accompanying a drainage application dated 1859.



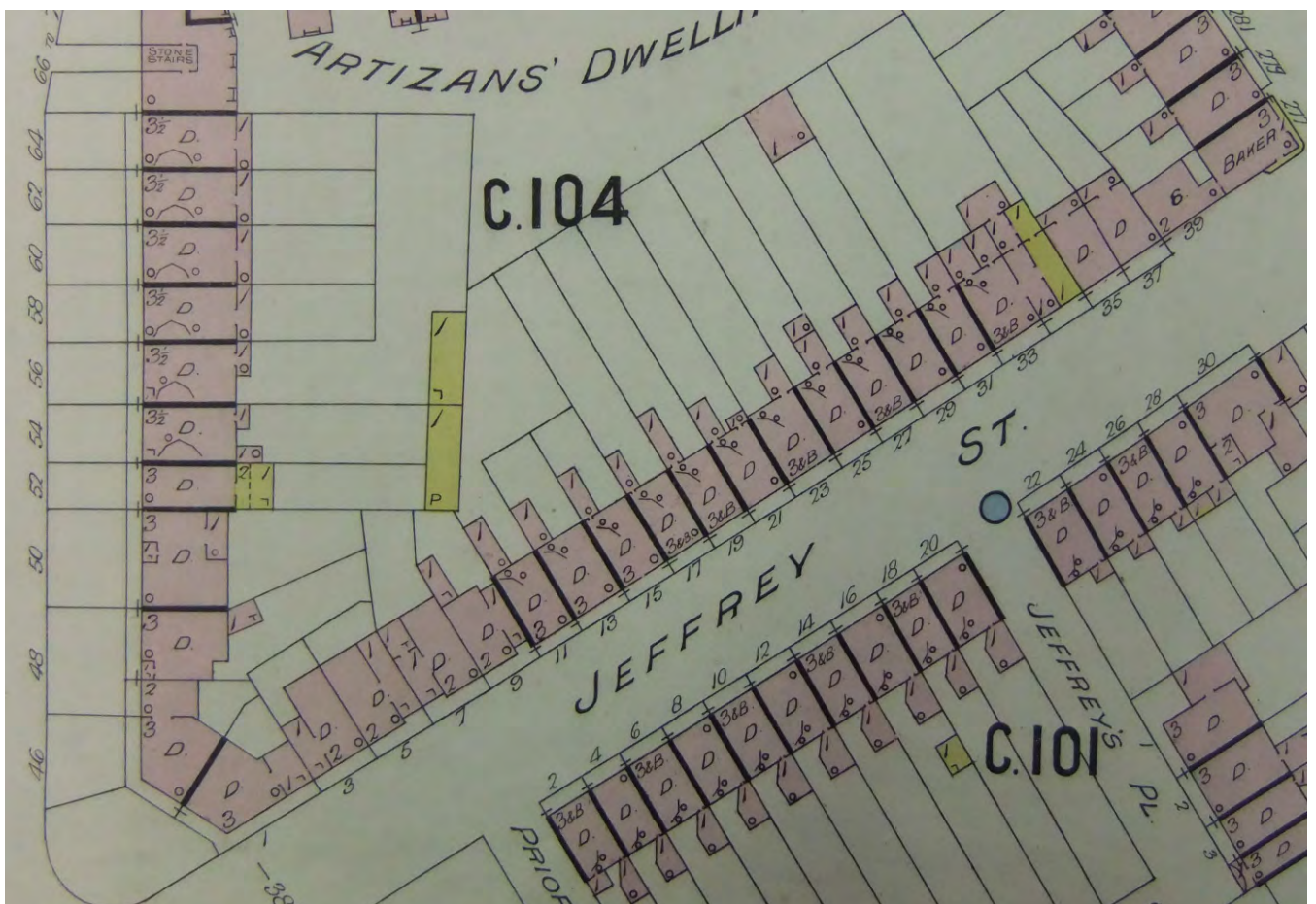

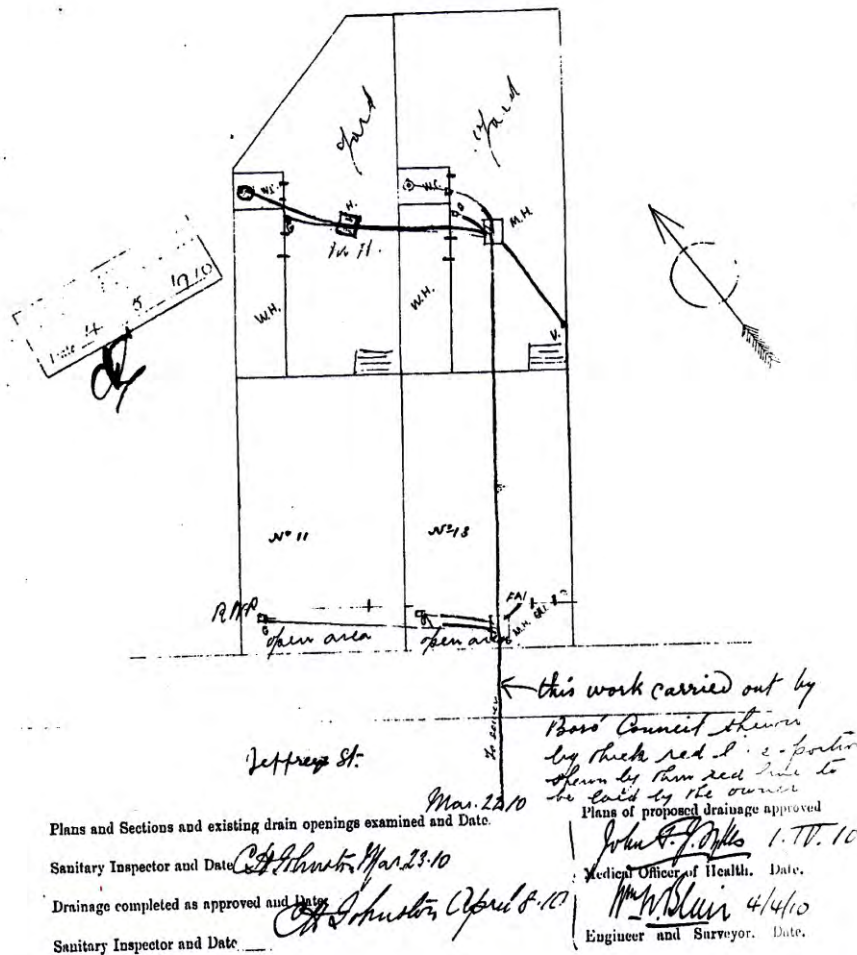

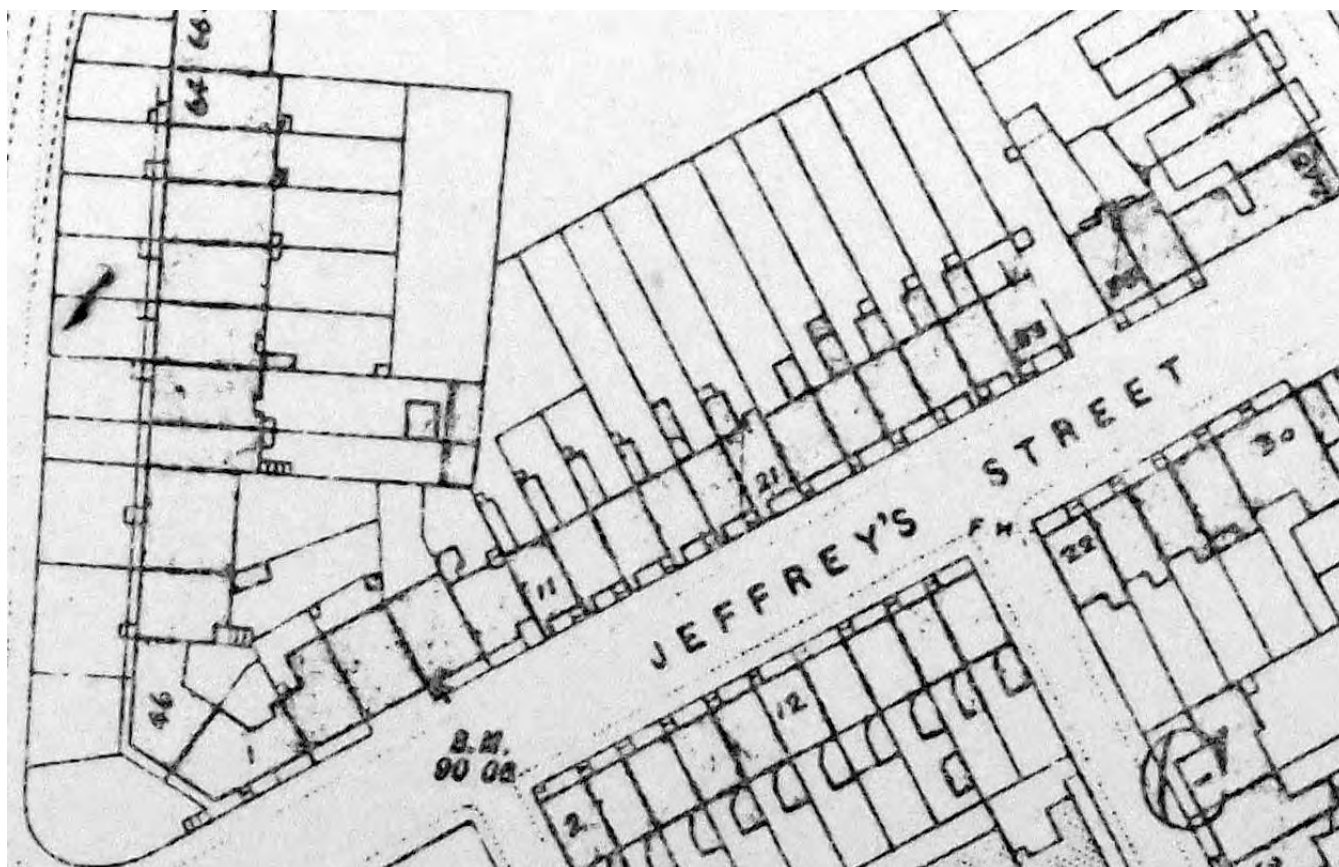

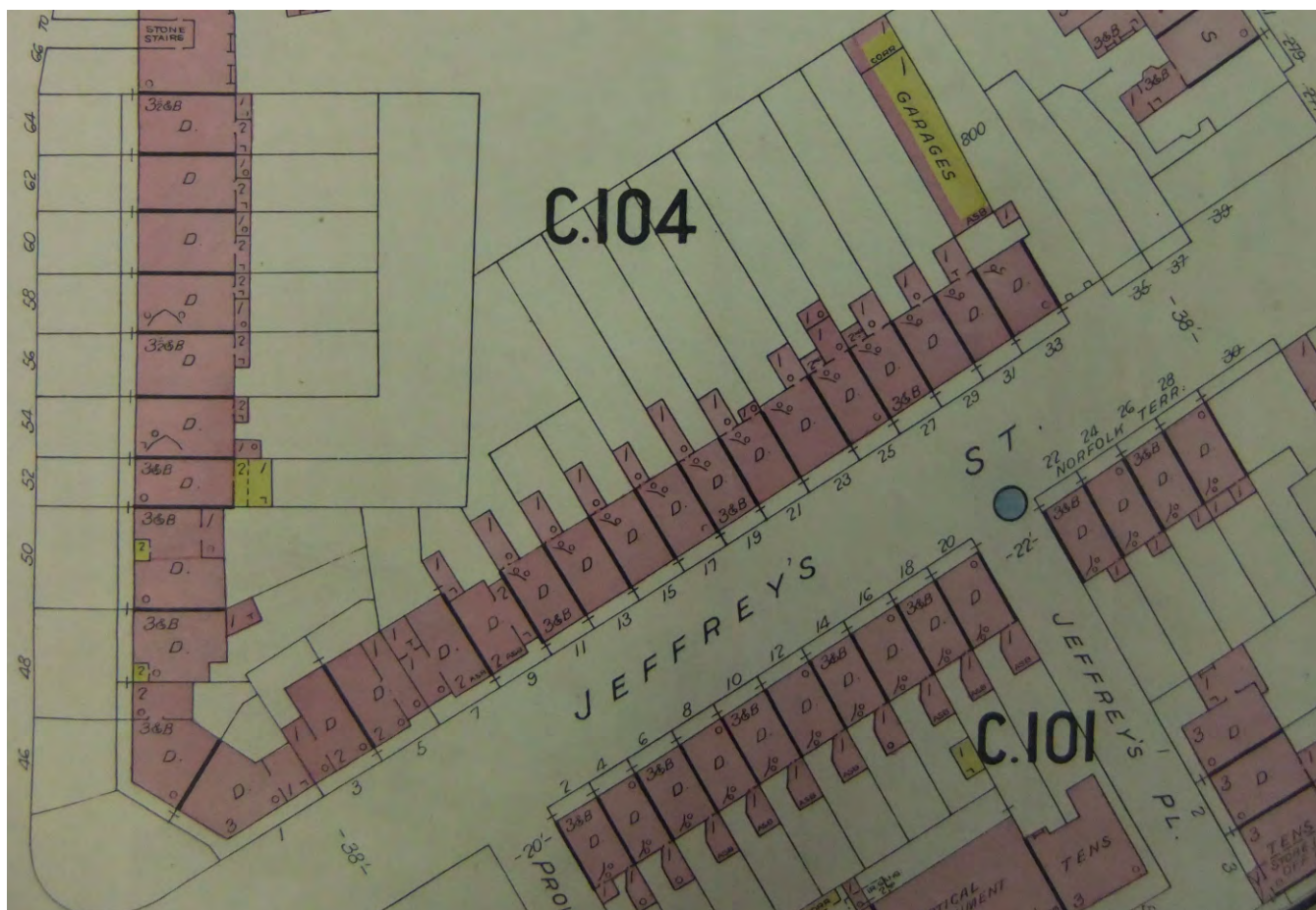


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Appendix 3: 3.7 Joint drainage application drawing for numbers 11 and 13, 1910.
