Proposed Work:

FRONT/SIDE GARDEN: 1 x Hawthorn & 1 x Privet - Reduce crown by approx. 25% ensuring clearance from the building by 0.5-1m. Cut back overhang on road side back to boundary line. Raise crown to give 2.5m clearance over the pavement.

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Holly - Fell.

1 x Plum - Reduce crown by 20%. Raise crown over the pavement to give 2.5m clearance. Cut back from building to give 1.5m clearance.

1 x Loquat - Reduce crown by 25%.

1 x Apple - Fell.


The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 28 July 2011 and does not wish to object.
