Proposed Work:

WITHIN THE GROUNDS: 1 x Lime - Crown reduce by 25% and shape. Remove deadwood and prune to clear building by 3-4m.

2 x Robinia - Remove dead, dying, diseased, broken and crossing limbs. Remove suckers and epicormic growth. Reduce canopy from buildings, street furniture and fixed objects to give 1-3m clearance. Lift canopy over public carriageways and pathways to statutory heights.

Adjacent Sapling - Fell.

- 2 x London Plane crown lift over the road to 8m. Prune to clear building by 6m and remove overhanging deadwood.
- 1 x Robinia Fell to ground level.
- 1 x Horse Chestnut Remove dead, dying, diseased, broken and crossing limbs. Remove suckers and epicormic growth. Reduce canopy from buildings, street furniture and fixed objects to give 1-3m dearance. Crown thin by 10% and lift over the road to 8m.



- 1 x London Plane Remove dead, dying, diseased, broken and crossing limbs. Remove suckers and epicormic growth. Reduce canopy from buildings, street furniture and fixed objects to give 1-3m clearance. Lift canopy over public carriageways and pathways to statutory heights. Crown thin by 10%. Remove south west low limb over car park and lift remainder to 6m.
- 1 x London Plane Remove dead, dying, diseased, broken and crossing limbs. Remove suckers and epicormic growth. Reduce canopy from buildings, street furniture and fixed objects to give 1-3m clearance. Lift canopy over public carriageways and pathways to statutory heights. Crown thin by 10%. Prune to clear building by 5m. Crown lift to 6m.
- 1 x Bay Crown reduce by 20% and shape.
- 1 x Elder Fell to ground level.
- 2 x London Plane, 1 x Fig & 1 x Sycamore Lift to 6m over the road.
- 1 x Cherry Lift to 6m over the road and prune to clear building by 3-4m.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 04 August 2011 and does not wish to object.

Informative(s):

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.
- You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
- Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
