<b><u>SPECIES</u></b>	<b><u>WORK PROPOSED</u></b>
<b><u>Rear</u></b>	
1 Purple -leaf Filbert ( <i>Corylus maxima</i> 'Purpurea')	Large , mature tree. This tree is outgrowing its location. Suggested works are: to reduce and re-shape the crown by 30% , clean out crown, remove deadwood.
<b><u>Rear</u></b>	
2 Silver Birch ( <i>Betula pendula</i> / <i>alba</i> )	Ivy covered tree. This was originally twin stemmed but one half has collapsed and has been removed. The remaining stem is smothered in Ivy. Suggested works are : to fell to ground level by sectional takedown and treat stump to prevent re-growth.
<b><u>Rear</u></b>	
5 Silver Birch ( <i>Betula pendula</i> / <i>alba</i> )	This tree has <i>Discula betulina</i> , which is a fungal disease causes numerous small, blackish spots on leaves which yellow and fall prematurely. Quite common and defoliation can be severe but it is not known to cause any lasting damage to the tree. To reduce the risk of re-infection in the following spring it is recommended that the fallen infected leaves are collected up and removed from the site or destroyed.
