Further to our conversation yesterday, I now attach photos of the dying/almost dead silver birch at the above address. Although there is still some residual leaf growth, the tree is dangerous. A limb fell off it last month (photo of the two pieces into which it broke attached) but fortunately landed in our garden (with no damage to the house or to anyone) rather than on the pavement or next door.

It is clear to me and to the tree surgeon who inspected the tree that, sadly, it has to be removed. Please will you confirm that we can proceed with that removal.
