8no wall mounted lanterns are proposed, 2 either side of the four doors on the south facade leading out onto the terrace. The lanterns are fixed to the exterior wall with screws. Cables will run through the wall behind each lantern and then chased into the internal block work. The internal finishes have already been stripped out as part of the ongoing consented refurbishment of the house (Application No:) so no intrusion into the listed building beyond drilling the lantern fixings and the 25mm holes for the cable through the external skin behind each lantern is required. The lantern positions are shown on LDI plan 5071-02 (plan) and 5071-03 (elevation). Lantern details are described in LDI doc 5701 Lighting Key
