The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposal to open the folding doors on the Shorts Gardens elevation would result in the erosion of the shopfront appearance with an incongruous void that would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the building and of the Seven Dials (Covent Garden) Conservation Area and is contrary to policies CS14 - Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage, DP24 - Securing high quality design and DP25 - Conserving Camden's heritage of Camden's Local Development Framework and DP30 - Shopfronts.



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
