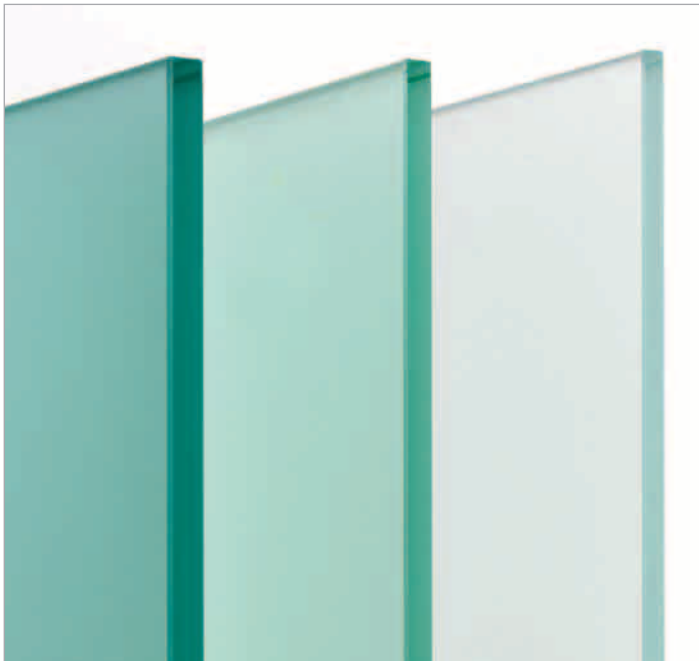

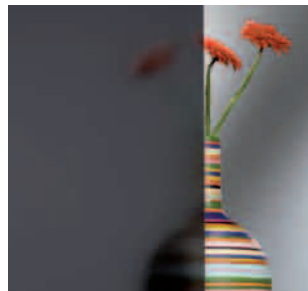

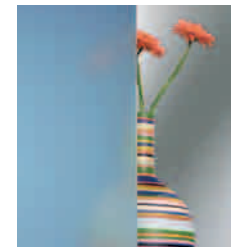

MATELUX is a clear or tinted float glass with acid-frosted surfaces. This process is carried out industrially on sheets of glass to ensure uniformity and continuity. Ever mindful of the environment, AGC Flat Glass Europe neutralises the chemical products used during the manufacturing process.

CLEAR GLASSES

Satin finish on 3 types of float glass :

- Etched, **clear float glass** in classic, light and double-sided versions ;
- Etched, **Clearvision extra-clear float glass** with a highly refined clear satin finish ;
- Etched **Linea Azzurra float glass**, with a clearly visible blue tinge on the edge of the glass.

6 products :

- **Matelux Clear** : translucent, clear float glass ;
- **Matelux Light** : clear, slightly translucent float glass ;
- **Matelux Double Sided** : translucent clear float glass frosted on both sides. This technique enhances the frosted effect ;
- **Matelux Clearvision** : extra-clear translucent float glass ;
- **Matelux Linea Azzurra** : frosted **Linea Azzurra float glass**. The special features of this glass are its slightly blue appearance and the ease with which it can be cut. Also available in 15 mm and 19 mm thicknesses for applications requiring thicker glass, such as tables and other furniture.
- **Matelux Antislip** : satin-finish glass that has been specially treated to give it anti-slip properties (performing in the category R10 as per the German standard DIN 5113). An ideal application for floors and stairs.

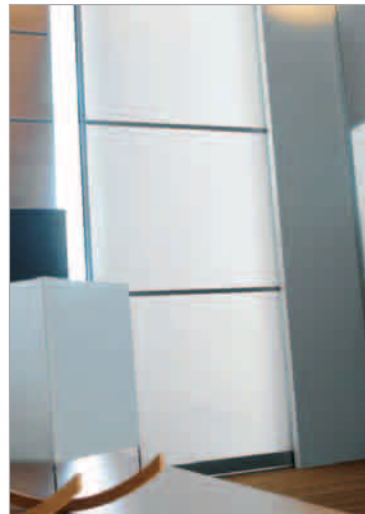
COLOURED GLASSES

Five colours available :

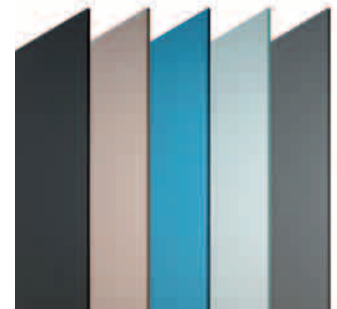
- **Matelux Bronze** : etching on bronze float glass ;
- **Matelux Green** : etching on green float glass ;
- **Matelux Grey** : etching on grey float glass ;
- **Matelux PrivaBlue** : etching on dark-blue float glass ;
- **Matelux Dark Grey** : etching on dark grey float glass.

LAMINATED safety VERSION

A laminated (safety) version of Matelux is also available with one or both sides frosted.

Specific application of the MATELUX STOPSOL range

Float glass with one side covered in a Stopsol reflective coating and the other with an acid-frosted coating. The reflective coating should always be applied to the base side.

Available in three tints :

- Matelux Stopsol Supersilver Clear ;
- Matelux Stopsol Supersilver Green ;
- Matelux Stopsol Supersilver Dark Blue.

Matelux Stopsol is designed for use in interior (furniture) and exterior (spandrels) applications. When used in spandrels, it offers a number of aesthetic benefits :

Its colour **harmonises perfectly** with the corresponding Stopsol vision glass.

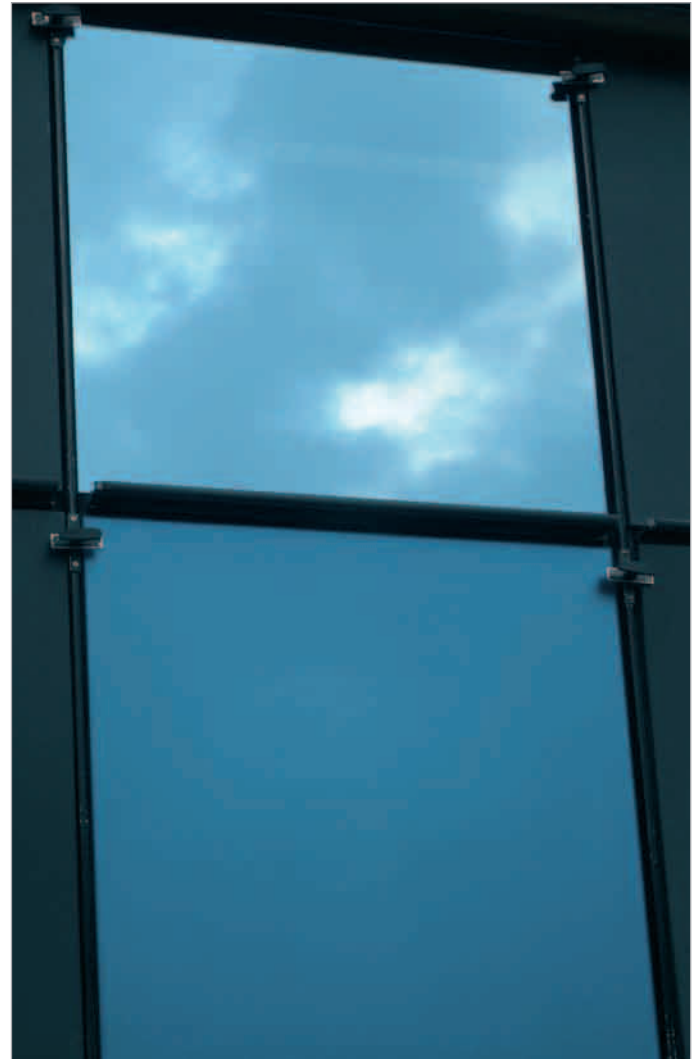
Contrast between the appearance of the (neutral or reflecting) vision glass and the satin-finish spandrel.

"Dynamic" appearance: in rainy conditions, the wet glass is glossy and reflective; in sunny weather it has a metallic appearance and a satin finish.

ADVANTAGES

■ Appearance

The acid-frosting technique can be used to gently obscure the surface of the glass. Treating the surface in this way guarantees translucent glass with a satin finish noted for its fine grain.

■ Ease of processing

Matelux has the mechanical and thermal properties of base (float) glass. It can therefore be toughened, laminated, assembled as double glazing, bevel cut and so forth.

■ Ease of maintenance

Highly stain-resistant, Matelux can be cleaned using clear water only without any special detergent.

■ Endless interior and exterior applications

Whether used in the bedroom or living room, in shops or restaurants, to adorn façades or provide privacy in interior partitions, Matelux is the glass of choice in a wide range of applications.

■ High light transmission

Matelux has the same light transmission as float glass, attaining levels of up to 90%, depending on its thickness.

APPLICATIONS

Being such a versatile product, Matelux can be used in all manner of applications :

- **Interior uses:** shelving, partitions, doors, counters, floor tiles, stair tiles, shower screens, lighting, tables and many other types of furniture (in kitchens, bathrooms, offices and so on).
- **Exterior uses:** double glazing for façades, glazing for balconies, doors and more ...

Additional features :

- **Matelux Linea Azzurra Extra thick (8, 10, 12, 15 mm and 19 mm):** for tables, shelving, basin units, floors and stairs
- **Matelux Stopsol:** designed for use in spandrels as well as interior applications
- **Matelux Double Sided:** doors
- **Matelux Antislip:** floors and stairs

MATELAC, painted glasses with a satin finish

Some of AGC Flat Glass Europe's painted glasses are available in an acid-frosted version (the satin-finish coating is applied to the non-painted side). These glasses make up the **MATELAC range** - a collection of sophisticated glasses which create a velvety effect and are highly prized by furniture and interior design professionals.

	Assembly in double glazing	yes	For ease of maintenance, the acid-etched side should face the interior of the double-glazing assembly. However, silicon should not be used for the double-glazing joint when the acid-etched side is in position 2 or 3.

Moisture resistant		yes	When the acid-etched side of Matelux is exposed to water, the etching becomes less visible. It will revert to its standard appearance after drying.
