The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed fibre cement slate roof covering and inappropriate chimney repair materials and methodology, would be detrimental to the architectural integrity and character of this Grade II listed building and would not preserve its special architectural or historic interest. This is contrary to policies CS14 (Promoting high quality places and preserving our heritage); DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP 25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework 2010.



Informative(s):

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The use of a natural slate roof covering and the proper repair of the chimney stacks by repointing in an appropriate mortar would be more likely to be considered favourably and would preserve the health and longevity of the building and its fabric.

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
