Assessment		
The application site comprises a two-storey mid terrace single-family dwellinghouse situated on the		
east side Fairfax Place with no existing extensions. Highways officers have confirmed a service road at the rear of the property is under private ownership and service and is not part of the public highway.		
at the real of the property is under private ownership and service and is not part of the public highway.		
The proposed dormer window extension would be 8.2m wide, 1.8m high, and 3m long. The net increase in volume of the proposed development is calculated at <u>22.2 cubic metres</u> .		
The proposed dormer extensions are considered as permitted development by Schedule 2, Part 1		
Class B and Class C of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order		
1995 because:	-	
a) The volume of the proposed roof extension does not exceed 40 cubic metres, or increase the		
cubic content of the resulting dwellinghouse by more than 50 cubic metres.		
b) There are no existing extensions to the house.		
<ul> <li>c) No part of the extension would exceed the height of the highest part of the roof.</li> <li>d) No part of the extension would extend beyond the plane of the existing front roofslope which</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>No part of the extension would extend beyond the plane of the existing front roofslope which fronts a highway.</li> </ul>		
e) The dwellinghouse is not in a conservation area.		
f) There is no condition restricting permitted development rights.		
g) The rooflights will not result in a material alteration to the roof of the dwellinghouse.		
Given the above it is recommended to issue the Certificate of Lawfulness.
