We are looking to replace the existing speakers in the Grand Temple of Freemasons' Hall. The current speakers, which consist of several arrays backed up by a multitude of fill-in speakers and are visually extremely obvious (see: 'Existing speakers in Grand Temple - Jan 2011'), no longer function correctly. The proposed replacement speakers would consist of a pair of main line source speaker arrays and three pairs of point source enclosure speakers. All of the new speakers would be finished in the nearest RAL / Pantone colour equivalent to closely match the marble cladding to which they would be attached. This should bring a positive improvement to the Grand Temple by reducing the amount of clutter and replacing it with a more streamlined solution (see: 'Proposed speakers in Grand Temple - Jan 2011')

The current speakers consist of several arrays, which are either attached to the marble cladding or are free-standing. These speakers are backed up by a multitude of fill-in speakers at various points around Grand Temple. All of the speakers are visually extremely obvious, have been in use for many years and no longer function correctly.

Description of *proposed* materials and finishes:

The proposed replacement speakers would consist of a pair of main line source speaker arrays and three pairs of point source enclosure speakers to cover any (audio) blank spots. All of the new speakers would be finished in the nearest RAL / Pantone colour equivalent to closely match the marble cladding to which they would be attached. This should bring a positive improvement to the Grand Temple by reducing the amount of clutter and replacing it with a more streamlined solution.
