Memorial to the Jewish victims of the Holocaust consisting of 2,711 concrete slabs of varying heights arranged in a rigid grid pattern, representing a supposedly ordered system that has lost touch with human reason.

Memorial to honour the victims of the 7 July 2005 London Bombings comprising of 52 stainless steel pillars, collectively representing each of the 52 victims, grouped together in four inter-linking clusters reflecting the four locations of the incidents.
