## Site Description

Grade II listed building dating from 1932, built for stained glass artist Frank Salisbury in neo Tudor style. Since Salisbury's occupation the building passed into educational use for a number of years but with new ownership has now reverted back to a single dwelling house. The building fronts onto West Heath Road and sits on an elevated position. To the rear are extensive grounds. Planning permission and listed building consent have been granted for various alterations including the erection of a side extension, and works are underway.

#### Assessment

Condition 4 part c) seeks details of the railing to the first floor level terrace. Drawings have been submitted which demonstrate that the railings will be cast iron finished in black, affixed to a metal upstand, the base of which is positioned below the slab covering. The design of the railings has been taken from details elsewhere on the building, and matches recently approved staircase balustrading at the lower level.

The appearance and method of fixing is considered to preserve the building's appearance and special interest and the condition is therefore recommended for approval.
