Assessment

Proposal:

Advertisement consent is sought for the relocation of an internally illuminated freestanding advertising column. The column is currently located to the front of 82 Tottenham Court Road, this proposal would see it moved approximately 8metres south to the front of 80-81 Tottenham Court Road.

The advertising column measures (H) 5.3metres x (W) 1.4 metres with a canopy extending approximately 1.9metres from the centre.

It is constructed from steel, aluminium and toughened glass and is to be internally illuminated to a level of 450cd/m.

The column can display six posters, four of which will be commercial, two will display Council information.

Assessment:

As the proposal will involve the relocation of an already existing advertising column there is considered to be little impact in terms of amenity and safety matters. The Council's Transport Planning department was formally consulted on the relocation and confirmed that officers from the engineering and traffic section have no objections to the proposed location.

The illumination level of 450cd/m is considered to be acceptable given the size and location of the signage.

Recommendation: Grant Advertisement Consent.
