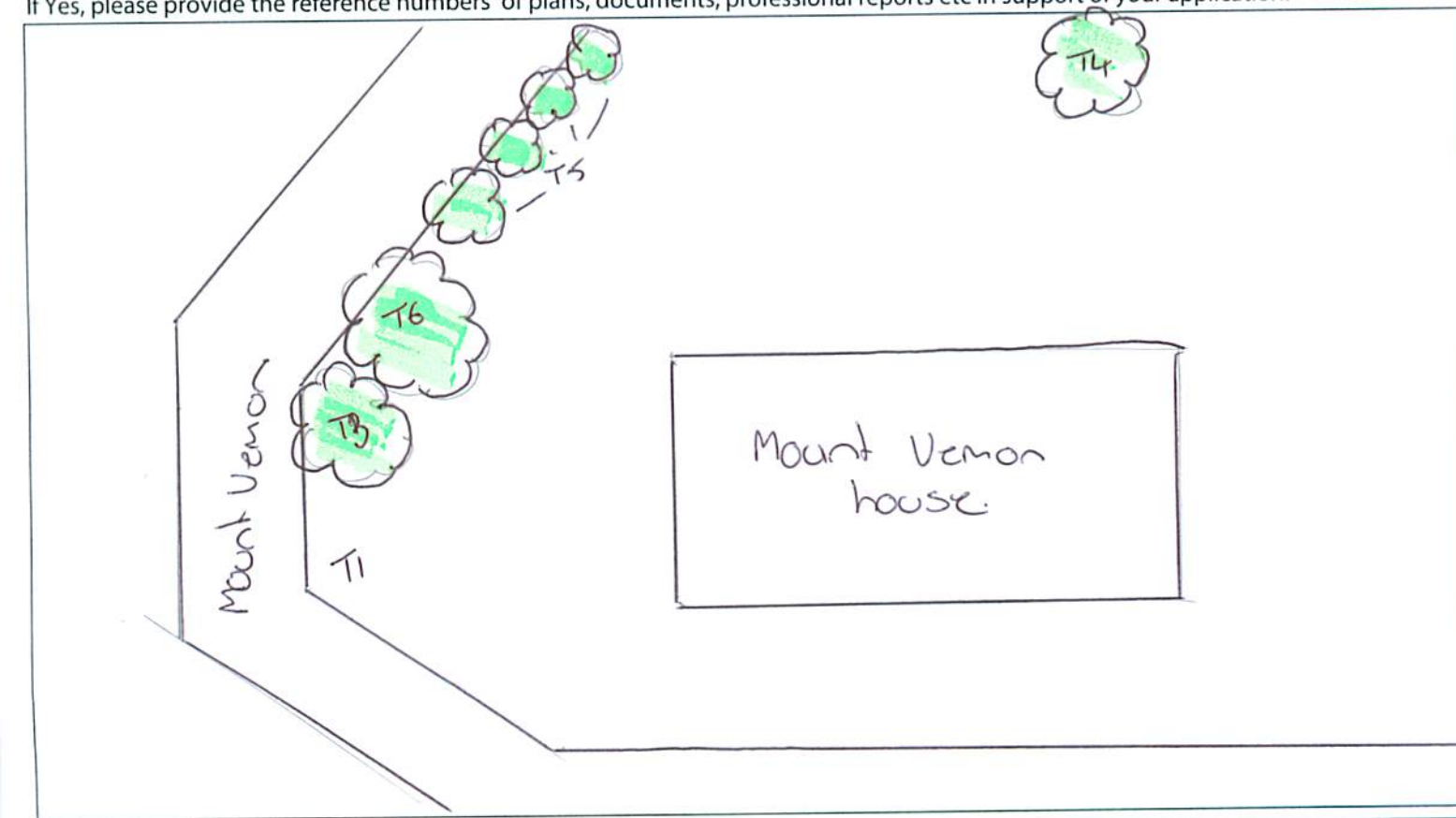

TREE: Holly Tree X 3

LOCATION: Rear Garden

- T1:** Reduce in height by up to 1m or to old pollard points and reshape the sides to make it more cone shaped. £[REDACTED]
- T2:** Small holly. Reshape sides. £0
- T3:** Reduce and reshape where necessary to maintain a ball shape. Prune back from the house and lift over the garden. Remove deadwood. £[REDACTED]
- T4:** Reduce in height by 0.5m and reshape sides to make it more cone shaped £[REDACTED]

TREE: Lime Tree (*Tilia sp.*)

LOCATION: Rear left of garden

WORKS: These are a line of six trees forming a protective screen from the neighbors.

- T5:** The four smaller trees should be brought down to 0.5 meters below previous reduction points to maintain an even line with the surrounding trees. This will also allow more light to the neighbors behind. Reduce and reshape the sides maintain an even screen along the back. Remove dead wood. £[REDACTED]
- T6:** The two larger trees (closest to the house) are taller in height than the rest and could do with being brought down to match. This will allow more light into the garden and restrict encroachment on the house. Reduce and reshape the sides maintain an even screen along the back. Remove dead wood. £[REDACTED]
