T1 = LARGE LIME - reduce as per pervious practice, remove basal and epicormic shoots

NB. Upon inspection it was noted this tree has decay on the main stem. While at this point the sound wood of the tree would appear to be supporting tree well enough we would recommend the tree be inspected regularly to monitor its condition and be placed on a strict 3 year cyclical maintenance plan

T2 = LARGE LIME - Reduce as per previous practice remove basal and epicormic shoots

NB. This is a service road to the rear which could serve as access - inform the tenant and he will arrange this. Entrance is via electric gates with a trades button
