Change of use from Hostel/House in Multiple Occupation (use class sui generis) to a single dwelling house (class C3).

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed change of use, by reason of the loss of a Hostel/House in Multiple Occupation, would result in a reduction in the supply of low-cost housing within the borough to the detriment of those on low incomes and in greatest need of housing. This would be contrary to the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006 policies H6 (Protection of houses in multiple occupation)



- and H9 (Hostels); the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy 2010, policy CS6 (Providing quality homes); and the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development 2010, Policy DP9 (Housing with shared facilities).
- The proposed development, in the absence of a legal agreement for car-free housing, would be likely to contribute unacceptably to parking stress and congestion in the surrounding area, contrary to policies T7 (Off-street parking), T9 (Impact of parking) and SD2 (Planning obligations) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.; policies CS11 (Promoting sustainable and efficient travel) and CS19 (Delivering and monitoring the Core Strategy) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; and policies DP18 (Parking standards and limiting the availability of car parking), DP19 (Managing the impact of parking) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
