The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The height and width of the proposed extension, in combination with its detailed design, would not relate to the host building or wider context, would obscure the rear elevation of the building and adversely impact on long views of the terrace to an unacceptable degree and would introduce alien design elements which do not
