6.0 Public Realm Ossulston Street

On the north west side of the building the massing has been stepped back as a means of addressing Ossulston Street. The building is set back from the junction of Ossulston Street and Brill Place creating a sunny public space with a grass lawn and fragrant climbing plants on the west facing wall. A large plane tree will be planted on this corner to soften views of the building and to link with the existing mature street trees.

6. 18

Additional street tree planting is proposed along both Ossulston Street and Brill Place to soften the elevations and integrate with the neighbourhood. The existing pattern of pavement build-outs with trees will be used to accommodate Blue Badge parking and reduce the apparent width of the roads.




Fig 6-13. Public realm plan west; boundary trees are subject to approval of LBC as highways authority and effected utility companies
