## Listed building application for antenna and satellite dish

### History

Sarum Chase at 23 West Heath Road is a private family residence in an existing building owned by Frank Salisbury, which is Grade II listed. It had planning and listed building consent for the extension and alteration of the property and its garden. The building is currently on site.

### Site Description

The building is ramped up from street level. A drive with planting on either side will guide visitors to the main entrance. The neighbouring buildings along West Heath Road are more or less the same distance away from West Heath Road as Sarum Chase.

### Proposed Antenna

The proposed antenna is to be kept in line with the

antennas of the neighbouring buildings. The satellite dish will be hidden behind the parapet and chimney.

The 3 antennas would be mounted together at the top of a mast, with the lowest antenna being at 1200mm above the chimney and the highest at 1800-2000mm. The mast would be mounted with two no chimney strapping kits c/w associated brackets. The final antenna heights are to match those of the adjacent installations.

The dish will be 900mm in diameter and would be mounted at the base of the antenna mast/chimney behind a parapet. All fixings would be with chimney straps to avoid drilling or being bolted to the structure.
