Display of twelve projecting signs at first floor level and 3 wall mounted board signs at ground floor level at existing shop (Class A1)

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** advertisement consent for the following reason:

Reason for Refusal

The proposed signs, by reason of their size, location and cumulative impact, would result in the addition of unacceptable visual clutter to this prominent corner building to the detriment of the appearance of the building and the character and appearance of the Camden Town Conservation Area contrary to policies B1 (General design principles), B4b (Advertisements and signs) and B7 (Conservation Areas) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.
