

<p><b>Site Address</b></p>	<p><b>7-8 Early Mews, Camden Town, London NW1 7HG</b></p> <p>CRI intend to use the premises to operate the Camden Alcohol Structured Day Programme which consists of a Community Structured Day Care Programme</p>
<p><b>Description of Development</b></p>	<p>There are currently two entrances to the premises, There is a door buzzer at the main door which can be reset at low level this will also be provided for DDA Access.</p> <p>The ground floor will be dedicated to client services and will incorporate a series of interview/counselling rooms, and a group room. The second floor is dedicated as an administrative base for staff.</p> <p>The control of access to all areas will be controlled by digi-locks to all access doors; the doors will also benefit from safety glazed viewing panels and door closers and safety glazed viewing panels.</p>
<p><b>Key Access Issues</b></p>	<p>The main entrance for clients to the building will be via the main entrance clients will have to go through the reception area which will be controlled by the reception staff, the door will benefit from an intercom, CCTV and door release button controlled internally.</p>
<p><b>Entrance</b></p>	<p>When deciding on this particular site, the geographical location of public transport was a key factor, by the nature of our clients they will generally access the service on foot or by bus. The service is a few minutes walk from all major bus routes in Camden, the premises is also very close to Camden Town tube station. This close proximity allows all clients from the borough to access the service.</p>
<p><b>Location</b></p>	<p>The programme to be run from this site is structured to help people achieve lasting changes in their life and put an end to their alcohol misuse and offending lifestyle.</p>
