**RE: PROPOSED VODAFONE LTD / TELEFÓNICA O2 UK LTD INSTALLATION AT (CS 14698 - O2 9091 - VF 80451), ABC SELF-STORAGE, 145-147 YORK WAY, LONDON, N7 9LG**

This is a full planning application, and notice in accordance with the electronic communications code under the Telecommunications Act 1984 Schedule 2 as amended by the Communications Act 2003, for permission for the development of:

**The replacement of two O2 antennas with two O2/Vodafone antennas and installation of ancillary development thereto at ABC SELF-STORAGE, 145-147 YORK WAY, LONDON, N7 9LG (NGR: 529923 184852)**

Telefónica O2 UK Limited has entered into a network sharing agreement with Vodafone Limited pursuant to which the two companies plan to share network equipment on a number of sites across the UK. A joint project team has been created, called Cornerstone, to oversee these arrangements.

This agreement allows both organisations to:

- consolidate the number of base stations required through sharing which is in accordance with Government Policy, and therefore
- significantly reduce the environmental impact of network development

The application comprises:

- Prescribed fee - £335 (Cheque made payable to the London Borough of Camden)
