T2: Leyland Cypress: (Aprox. 12m on left hand side adjacent ash): Reduce height by aprox. 20%, trim face to tidy and control encroachment.

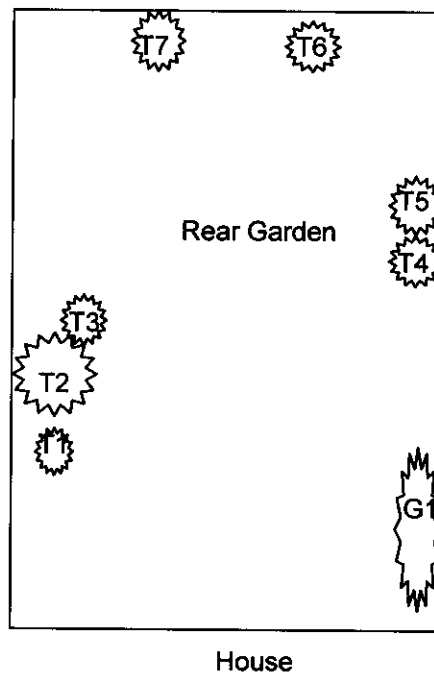
