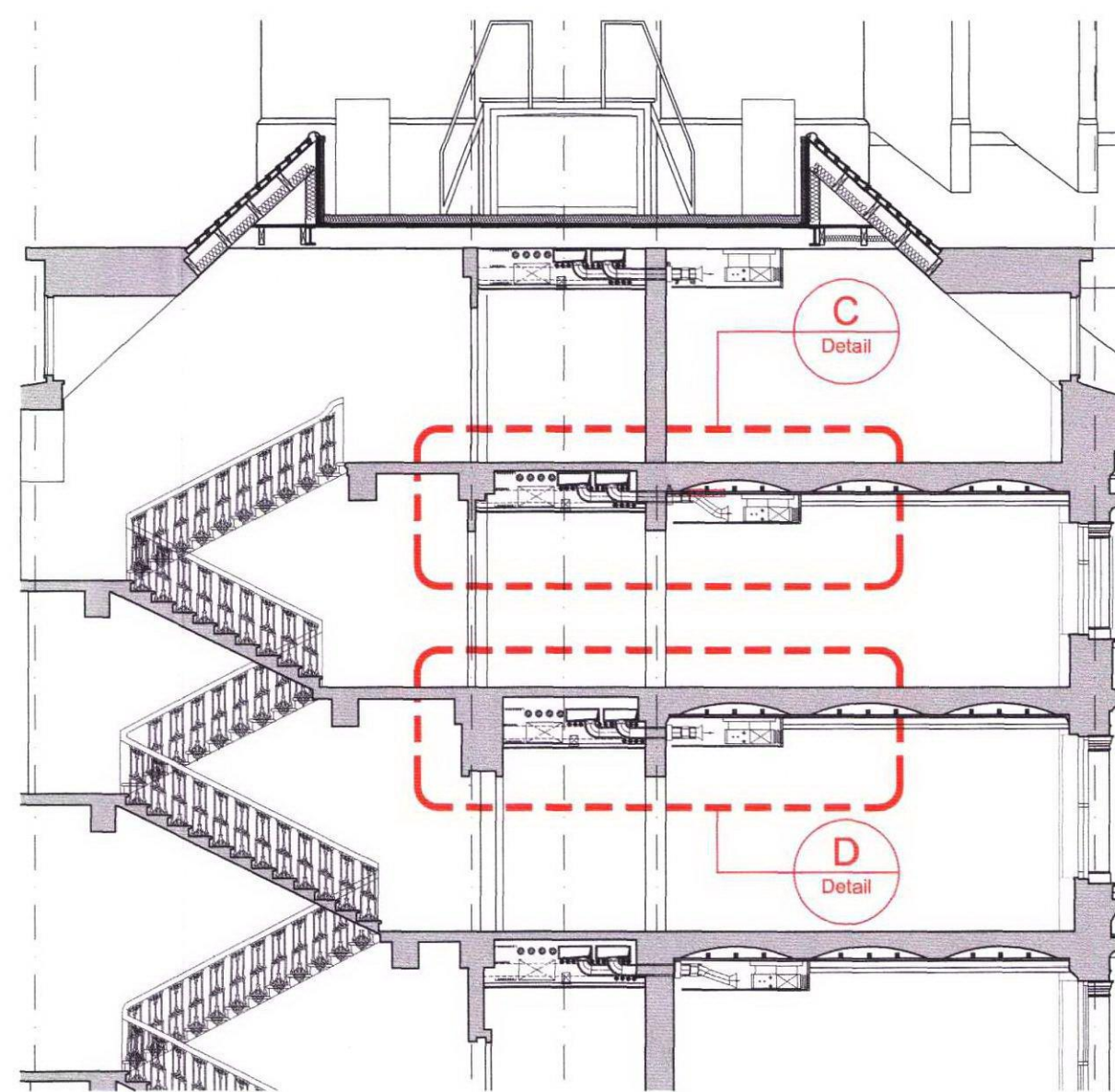
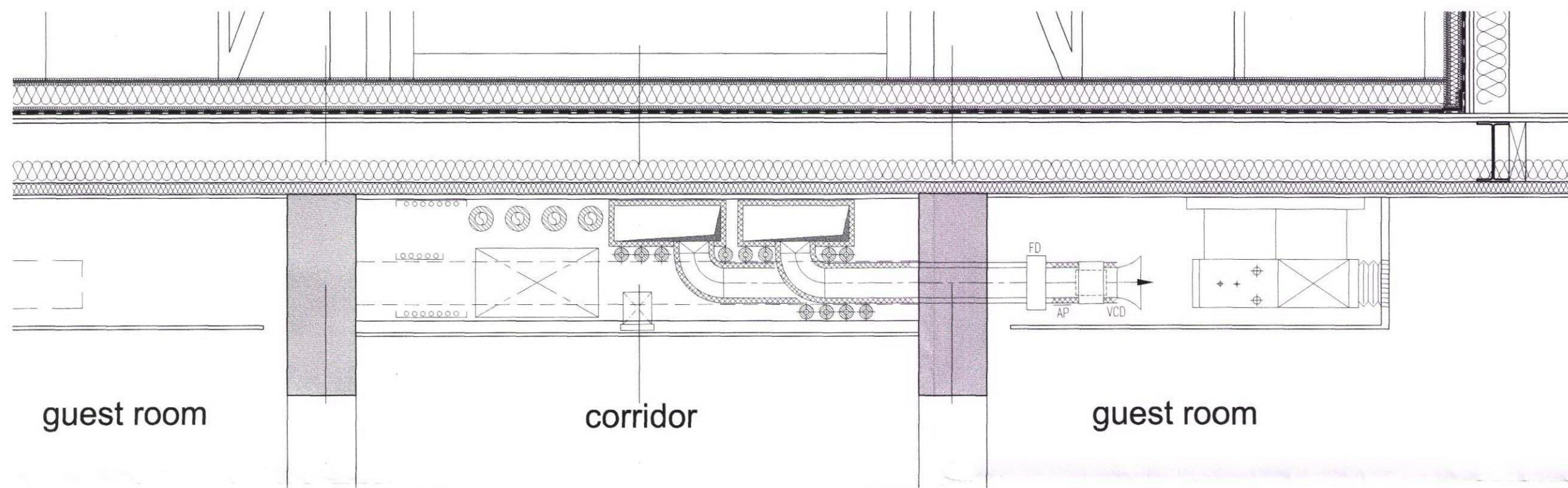


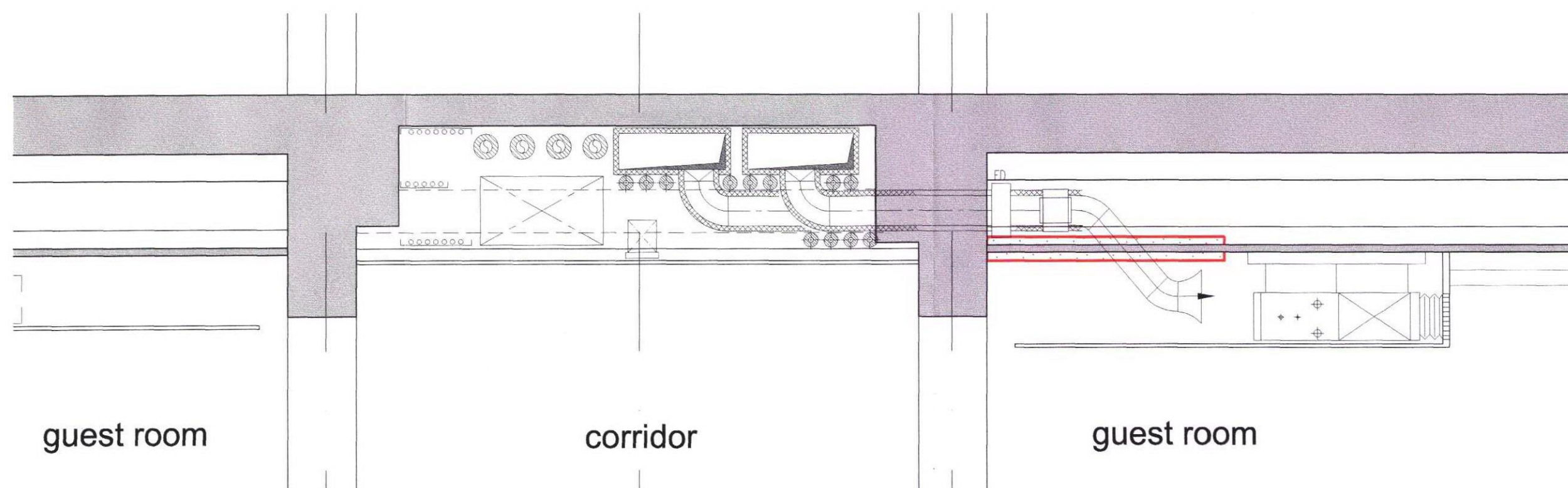

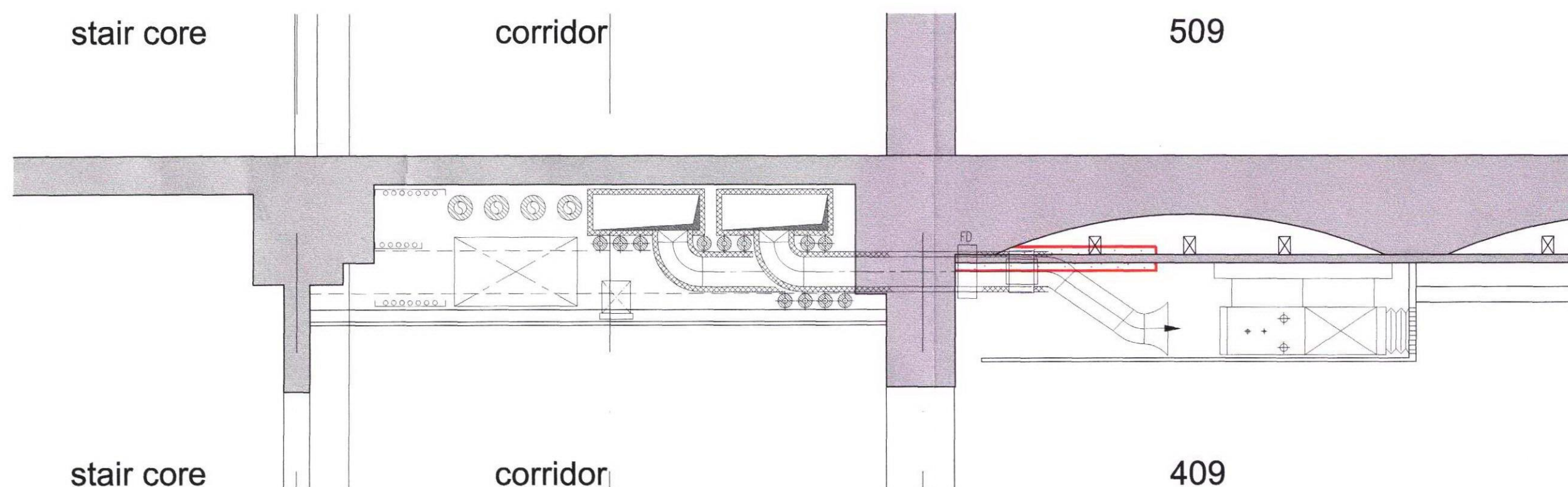

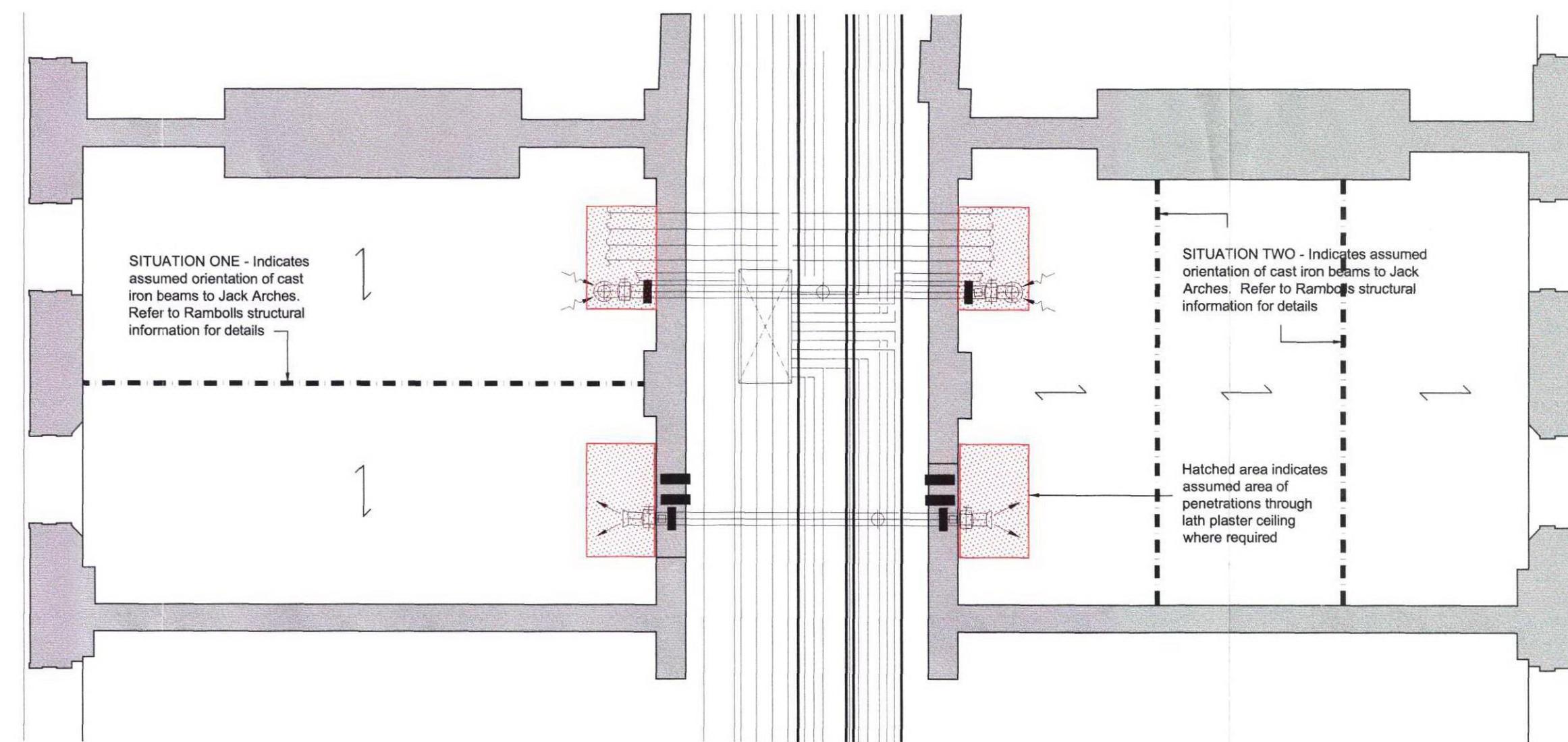
Detail A - New Roof Fifth Floor

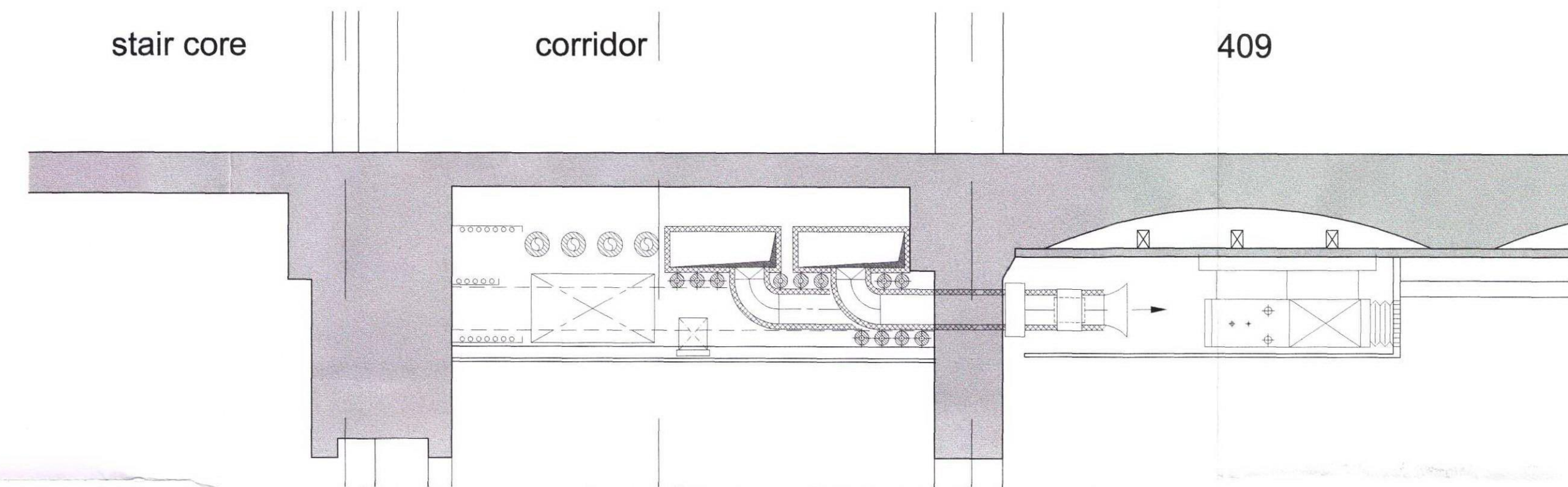
Detail B - First to Fifth floor typical service route through lath & plaster ceiling

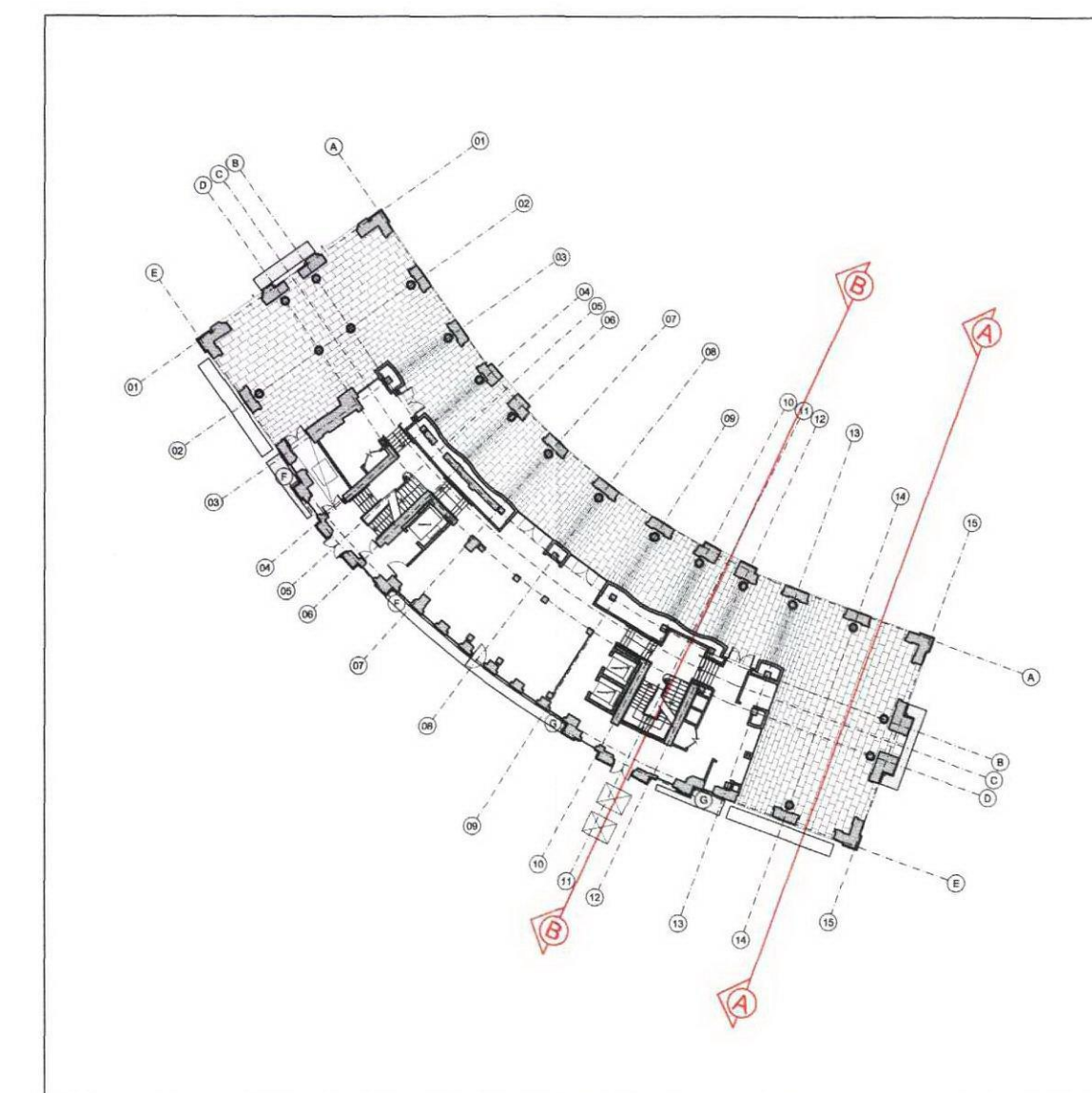
Detail C - Penetrations through brick Jack Arch rooms 404 & 409
