An application to extend hours on trading on Saturday evenings until 02:30hrs, subject to planning permission (as per a condition of the licence).

The extended hours will only be utilised post 01:30hrs for pre-booked functions only. Access to members of the public will be restricted after this hour. The Applicant proposes a condition in their operating schedule to reflect this intention:

"The premises shall not operate beyond 1.30am, save for pre-booked functions and with the exception of New Years Eve when the premises will be open to the public in accordance with the seasonal variation."

In addition, following consultation with Police, the Applicant seeks to amend the current Door Supervisor condition and create a requirement to provide advance notice to the Police of certain events. The revised condition and notice requirement are dealt with in additional proposed conditions below.

It is not intended that the style of operation will change as a result of this application and due to the existing good practices in place, the location of the premises and the limited nature of the variation it is not considered that the licensing objectives will be undermined by these proposals.
