INSTALLATION OF SCREEN HOUSINGS IN THE SOUTH CLOAKROOM AND MONTAGUE PLACE ENTRANCE LOBBY.

SOUTH CLOAKROOM: REMOVAL OF EXISTING HIGH LEVEL MDF FASCIA. CUT BACK EXISTING MDF PROMOTIONAL PANELS AT LOW LEVEL TO EXPOSE PLASTERS BEHIND. TWO PANELS TO BE REPLACED WITH LOW REFLECTANCE GLASS BEHIND WHICH WILL BE LOCATED MONITORS FOR DISPLAY OF "WHAT'S ON" INFORMATION ABOUT THE MUSEUM'S DAILY PROGRAMME.

MONTAGUE PLACE ENTRANCE: INSTALLATION OF TWO SHALLOW STELAE FIXED SLIGHTLY AWAY FROM EXISTING PLASTERS ON EAST AND WEST SIDES, 180MM OFF THE FLOOR ALLOWING EXISTING MARBLE SKIRTING TO RUN THROUGH UNDER. FACES AND EDGES OF NEW STELAE TO ALIGN WITH EXISTING JOINTS IN STONE FLOOR, AND DEPTH WILL BE A MAXIMUM OF 200MM. BOTH STELAE TO BE FACED IN LOW REFLECTANCE GLASS BEHIND WHICH WILL BE LOCATED MONITORS FOR DISPLAY OF "WHAT'S ON" INFORMATION.
