

Dear Sirs,

I am seeking authorisation for the tree works as detailed in the application and the enclosed sketch plan and pictures:

Specification of works to be done:

- Ash tree: Remove 3 lower limbs and reduce 30% of overall volume. Reason for the works: tree canopy is overhanging Lea Steps property and significantly reduces light and view over the Pond. The view over the Pond is protected by a "right of view" agreement between The Garden House, Lea Steps, Upfleet and other properties.

- Laurels: Remove trees. Reason for the works: the 2 young Laurels (must be no more than 5 years old) are self seedling and they obstruct the view over the Pond. The view over the Pond is protected by a "right of view" agreement between The Garden House, Lea Steps, Upfleet and other properties.

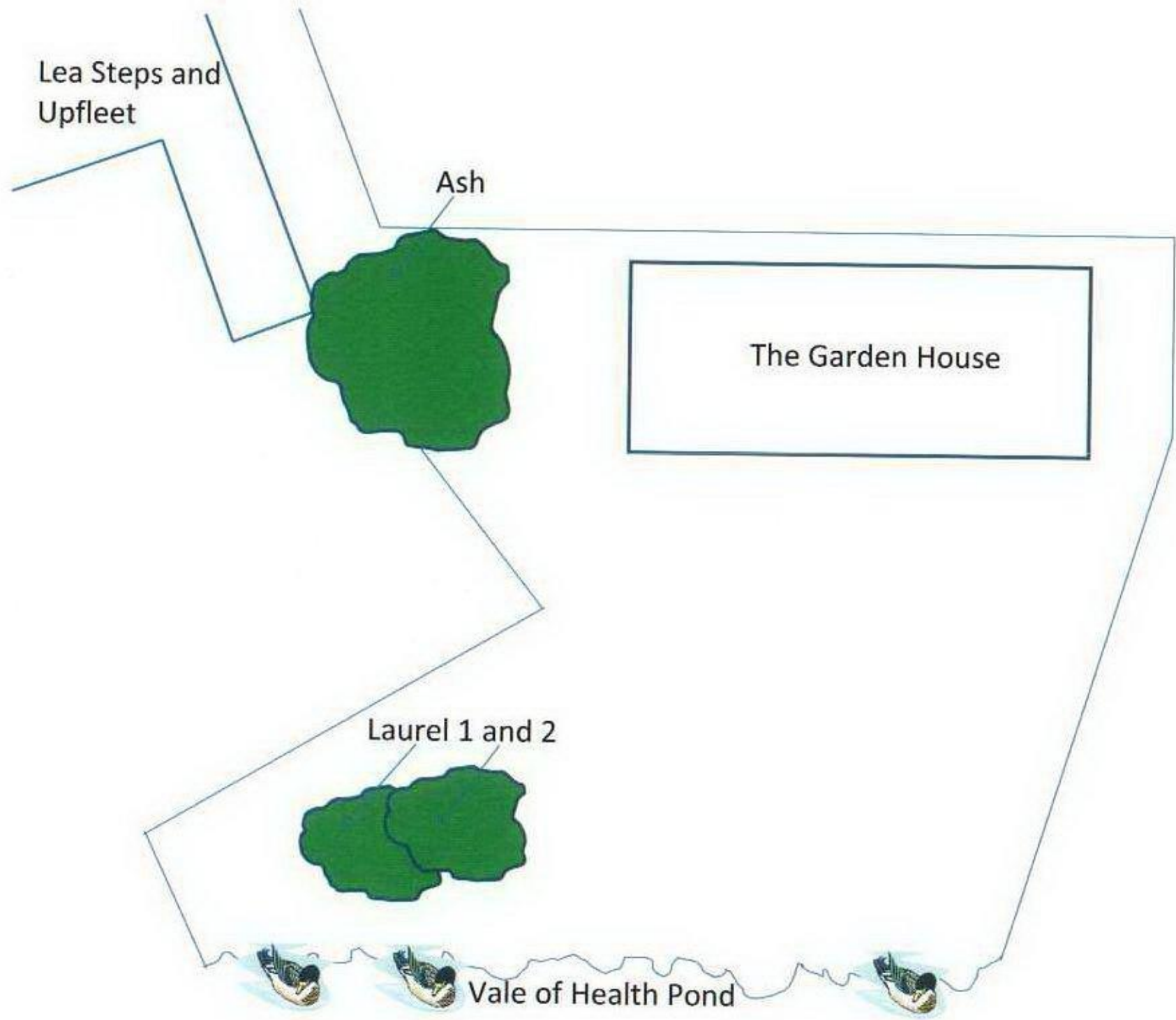

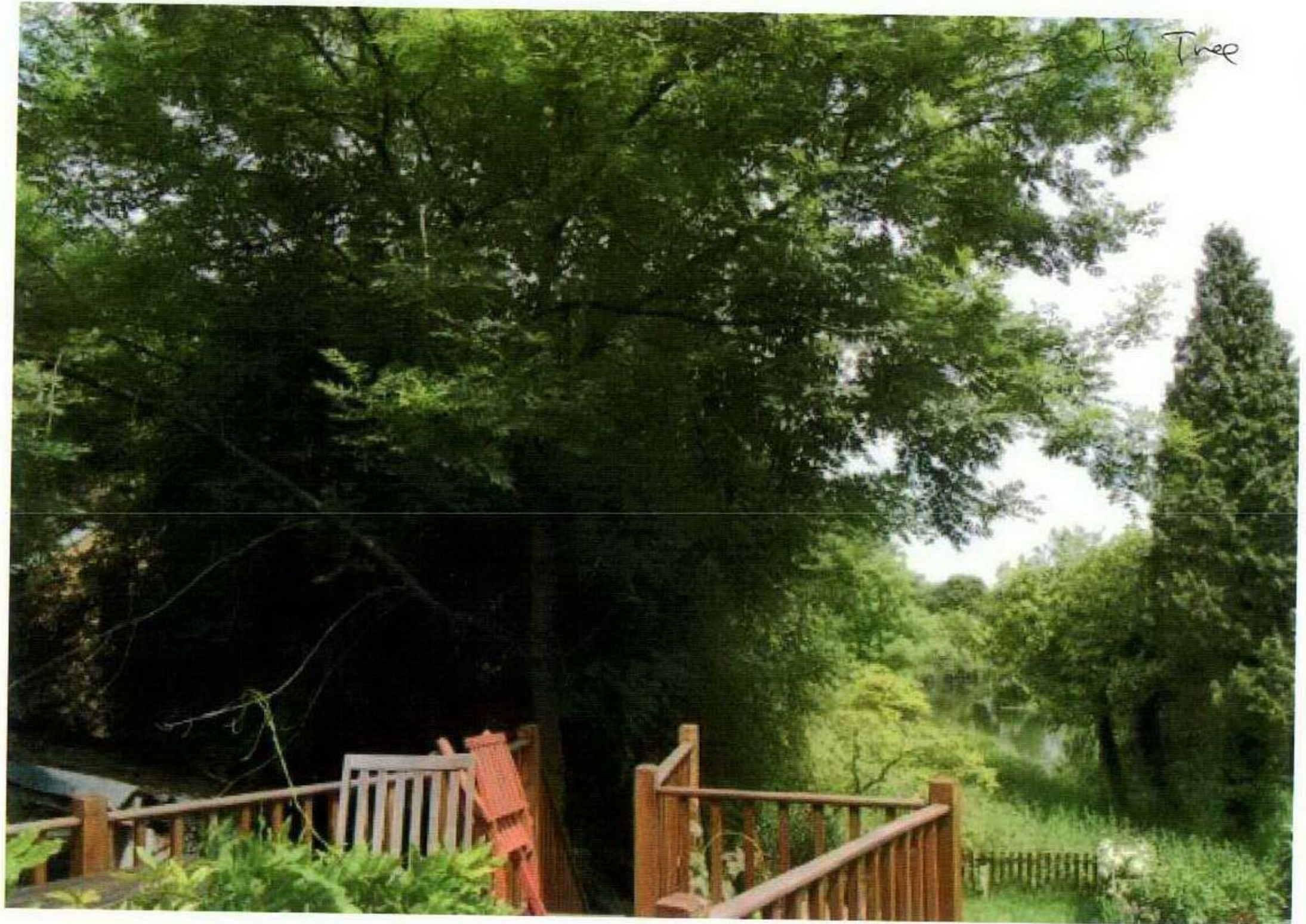

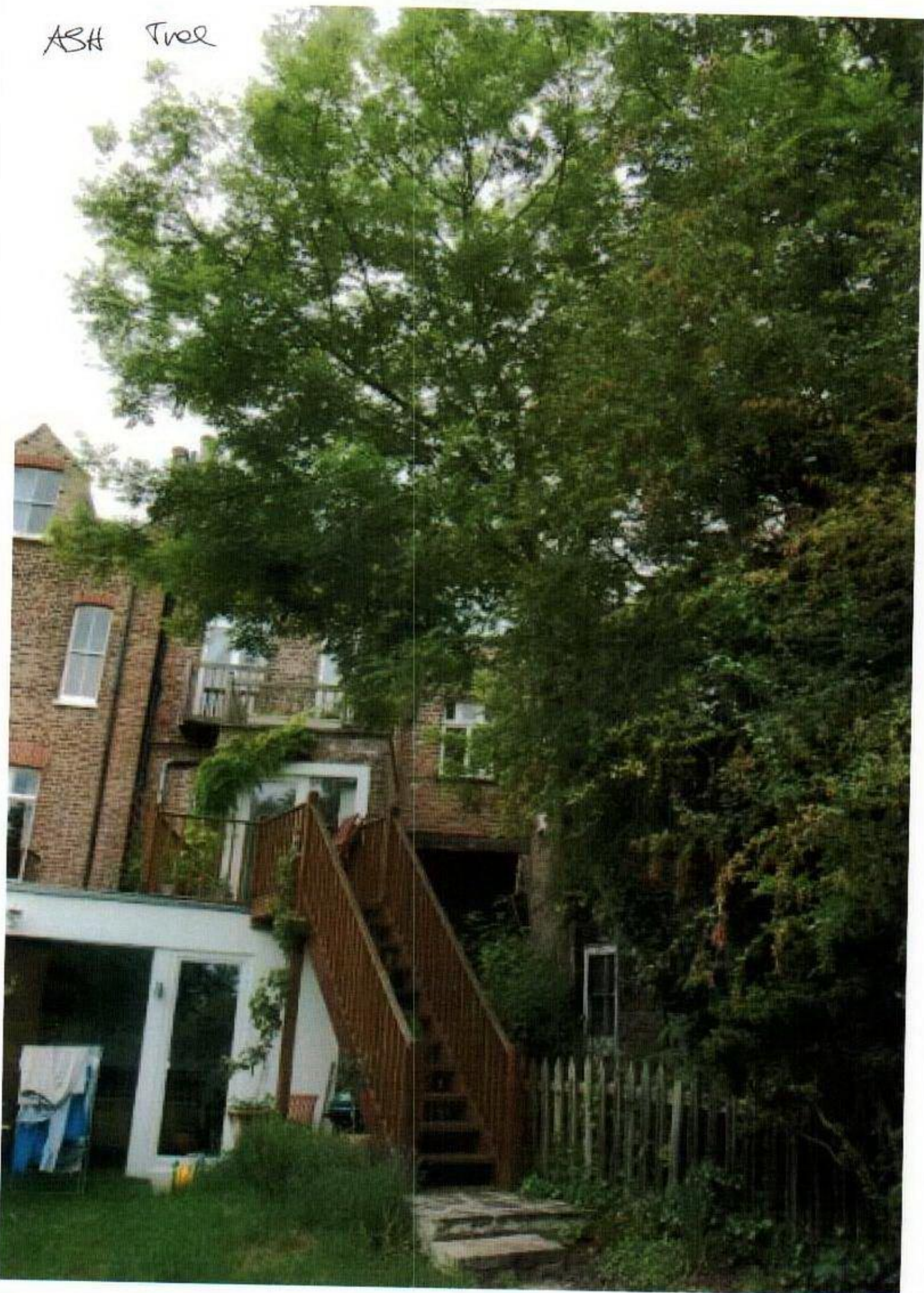
