The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 In the absence of sufficient evidence and justification to demonstrate that the previous use as a community use was surplus to requirements, or has been reprovided elsewhere or there is no demand for another suitable community use of the site, use of the site as a retail unit is considered to be contrary to the principle aim of Policy C2 (Protecting community uses) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.

1 You are advised that for an application for the loss of a community use to accord with policy C2 it would need to be clearly demonstrated through the submission of sufficient information that an adequate replacement facility has been provided in a location accessible to the users of the facility; or the specific use is no longer required and it can be demonstrated that there is no demand for another suitable community use of the site.
