Selectively cut back up to twelve branches overhanging the back garden boundary of 20 Asmara Road by between 2m and 3m from the branch tips, depending on the position of growth points and the shape and flow of the canopy.

REASON FOR PROPOSED WORK

To increase the space in the applicant's garden and to reduce the ground shading, without harming the amenity value of the tree.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The Council has previously considered that a 25% crown reduction would be appropriate (Ref CLS/CLT/RK15888/23 of 09 01 08) but such work has not been carried out. The crown spread over the applicant's garden is roughly between 7m and 11m, and the proposed work would represent less than a 25% foliage reduction.
