Dear Timothy,

Following on from our conversation, here is the specification outlined by the tree surgeon for the pruning of 3 trees in our back garden:

Cherry x 1: Crown reduce by 30%  
Prune to shape and balance

Baytree x 1: Crown reduce by 1.5-2ft  
Prune to shape and balance

Sorbus x 1: Crown reduce by 25%  
Prune to shape and balance

The second tree surgeon has not sent me his specification yet but was talking of up to 3 metres off the cherry & 1.5 to 2 feet off the bay; I can't recall his measurement for the sorbus, but it certainly was no more than the 25% suggested above.
