



REAR COMMUNAL area with access

T1 = MATURE MAGNOLIA - remove epicormic and basal growth

T2 = LARGE BEECH - crown thin 20%, cut back 2m from building

T3 = LEANING BEECH - crown thin 20%

T4 = LIME - re-reduce crown to previous pruning points, remove basal and epicormic shoots

NB: Access too tight for vehicles, so debris will have to be dragged
