Gas Holder:

5m³ bell over water gas holder. Shown in the photo attached - It is the tank in the foreground of the image, not the one behind.

It is built by Methanogen, the AD provider for this project. As it is a bell over water holder, the height will adjust according to the quantity of gas in it at any one time. The maximum it will rise to is 4m height. The diameter is 2.5m

Liquor Storage tank:

20m³ liquid holding tank. This will have the same diameter as the gas holder, 2.5m. It will be 4 meters tall. It will look very similar to the Gas holder, a small concrete base, painted the same dark green as in the photo. This is also built by the AD provider, Methanogen.
