Replacement of two existing timber sash front windows at second floor level with new PVCu sash windows to existing flat (Class C3).

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed replacement windows, by reason of their material, would appear incongruous and be detrimental to the character and appearance of the host building and the surrounding South Hill Park Conservation Area contrary to policies B1 (General design principles), B3 (Alterations and extensions) and B7 (Conservation areas) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.
