

Summary of Recent Planning History

14th June 2004

Original planning application refused by Camden Council.

13th June 2005

Councils decision was appealed (Ref: APP/X5210/A/04/1155950 & APP/X5210/E/04/1156608) by the applicant and was subsequently granted planning consent by the Planning Inspectorate.

J Ross Developments Ltd secured planning permission (LPA Ref: 2003/0792/C) and conservation area consent for the demolition of the existing warehouse building with the erection of a mixed use development including residential and office uses.

Planning Officer who dealt with the original application and the later appeal was Jenny Fisher.

29th May 2007

Listed Building Consent (2007/1200/L) granted for the partial demolition of a section of boundary wall adjacent to the rear of properties on Doughty Street.
