The works refer to the covering of an existing play area with a canopy.

Main Considerations

Impact on host building and the conservation area

The works are located within the compounds of the school however, they will be visible from the public realm through high boundary treatment. The covering of the courtyard areas with a simple white tensile roof over an aluminium frame is considered acceptable as it will read as subordinate to the host building. Due to its discrete position, the design is considered sympathetic to both the host building and the surrounding conservation area. There is no objection to the clear acrylic panels which is placed above the horizontal beam. It is considered that the works will preserve the character and appearance of its surroundings. The works are compliant with policies B1, B3 and B7 of the London Borough of Camden Unitary Development Plan.

Neighbourhood amenity

Due to the positioning of the canopy which is located a considerable distance from the boundary with the surrounding properties it is considered that the proposed works would not adversely impact on the amenity of the neighbouring properties with regards to access to sunlight, daylight, overlooking, visual bulk or sense of enclosure and is therefore considered to be consistent with policy SD6 of the UDP.
