Listed Building Consent Refused

Proposal:

Erection of mansard roof extension with two front dormer windows and rear roof terrace to add new floor to existing single family dwelling along with associated internal alterations (Class C3).

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed roof extension, by virtue of the inappropriate detailed design on its rear elevation, would be harmful to the appearance and special architectural and historic interest of this Grade II listed building contrary to policy B6 (Listed Buildings) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.



2 The proposed internal alterations involving repositioning of the bathroom on the second floor, by virtue of unacceptable intervention in the historic fabric, failing to respect historic features and loss of original/traditional plan form, would be harmful to the special architectural and historic interest of this Grade II listed building, contrary to policy B6 (Listed Buildings) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.
