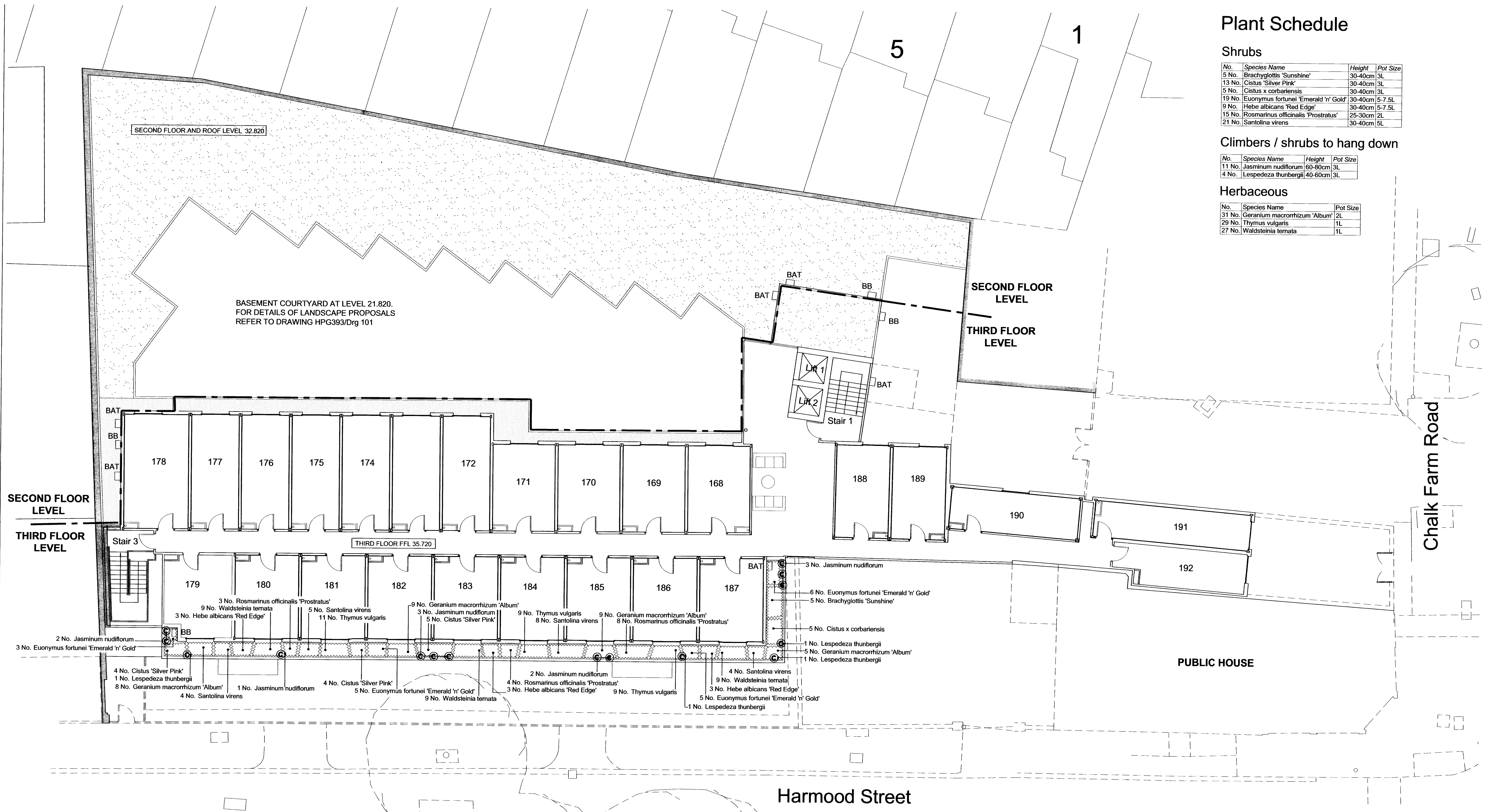

- KEY**
- Stone chipping / gravel surface on roof, aggregate size 10-14mm. Choice of stone to be determined.
 - Extensive green roof, planted with mixed Sedum carpet.
 - Shrub and groundcover planting as part of intensive green roof at third floor.
 - Climbing plants/ shrub species to be allowed to trail over edge of building and hang down.

- Timber "Sparrow Terrace" nest box, approx dimensions 400x350x185mm, from the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds. Each box to be secured to face of building as high as possible above second and third floors in locations as shown.
- Timber bat box, 330x140x180mm, from Alana Ecology. Each box to be secured to face of building as high as possible above second and third floor levels in locations as shown.

- NOTES:**
- Surface of planting bed at third floor, to be covered with a 50mm depth of cocoa shell mulch after planting.
 - Planting bed at third floor, to be watered using a trickle irrigation system.
