Proposal:

(TPO Ref: C774) FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Hawthorn - Fell to ground level and replace with Rowan.

The Council has considered your application dated 22 October 2009 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions and Reasons:

- This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.
 - Reason: To allow the Council to monitor the completion and standards of the work.
- 2 All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 1989. (Recommendation for Tree Work)

Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).



The Council requires that a Rowan (*Sorbus aucuparia*) be planted in the front garden as a heavy standard with a girth size of 16-18cms. The ground should be prepared to the standards set out in BS5236:1975. The tree should be suitable staked and tied. The replacement should be planted by the end of February 2010.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 206 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).

Informative(s):

Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife. Of particular note is the protection offered to bats, birds and their nests, whilst being built or in use. For further information contact Natural England on 0300 060 2634.
