**METHOD STATEMENT
FOR LIGHTING RAIL FIXED TO THE NORTH FACE OF THE
GRANARY BUILDING WALL**

Nature of the Proposal

To advise of the lighting rail to be fixed to the north wall of the Granary Building

Reason

To comply with the Planning Condition set out under Listed Building Consent 2007/5230/L Condition 21-a-xxi.

Method Statement

The lighting rail is a fabricated steel structure which is to be fixed to the existing brick wall of the Granary Building. The lighting rail includes a tubular hanging rail which is incorporated into the fabrication. The hanging rail is there to permit art to be hung without the need for temporary fixings into the brick wall. The structure incorporates light fittings to illuminate the space.

- The lighting rail is fixed to the north elevation of the Granary Building
- The Structural Engineer has advised that the fabricated lighting rail is to be fixed at 1000mm centres. Each fixing is to be made into the centre of the brick
- The fixings into the brick are to be 16mm diameter to accommodate a 12mm threaded rod which will be fixed, using resin, into the drilled hole.
- Fixings will be in pairs at 170mm centres.
- The steel fabricated frame will be given a paint finish, colour to be confirmed.
- Signage will be attached to the lighting track to confirm the safe working load of the hanging rail.
