REAR GARDEN with no side access

T1 = PYRACANTHA located in adjacent garden - cut back overhanging branches back to boundary line

T2 = BAY - trim tree as best as possible to achieve columnar shape

NB: Stepladders, pole hedge trimmer/pole saw and pole set necessary.

Client understands that there is a chance that this item may not be wholly feasible but requests we try.

T3 = CONIFER weak branch hanging up on shed roof - remove

G4 = HEDGE - reduce in height to match that of pillar adjacent

NB: Access is poor for this job - brings lots of dust sheets as drag is long and windy
